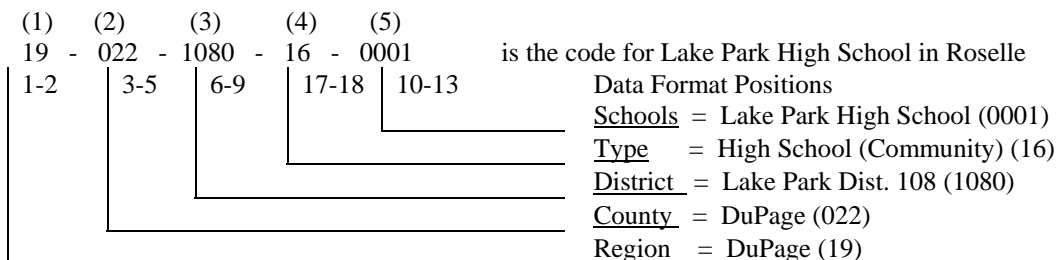


# KEY TO CODING: ILLINOIS SCHOOLS & DISTRICTS

Districts and schools in Illinois are identified by a unique code. This code is a combination of 15 numbers, or 14 numbers and 1 letter. The first 11 numbers (or 10 numbers and 1 letter) of the code identify the school district. The last four number identify the particular school in the school district. For example:



- (1) **Region Code:** A code of 2 numbers, from 01-57 for the 45 Regional Offices of Education. Each region is made up of one or more of the 102 Illinois counties. In addition, Region 60 is assigned to the Department of Corrections, and Region 65 is assigned to Other State-Funded Schools. (Region codes are listed in this document for reference purposes.)
- (2) **County Code:** A code of 3 numbers, from 001 to 102, assigned to each of the 102 Illinois counties in alphabetical order. In addition, number 000 is assigned to Regional Offices of Education, number 105 is assigned to the Department of Corrections, and number 108 is assigned to other State-Funded Public Schools. (County codes are listed in this document for reference purposes.)
- (3) **District Code:** A code of 4 numbers, or 3 numbers and 1 letter, which includes the legal identifier which the school district uses as its district name. If the fourth digit is a 5, the 5 represents one half.
- (4) **Type Code:** A code of 2 numbers that identifies the type of district or administrative agent:

- (5) **School Code:** A code of 4 numbers assigned to the school. The first digit indicates the kind of school and the remaining three digits are sequential. If the fourth digit is a "C", the school is a Charter School. The first two digits of Regional Offices of Education (ROEs) and Intermediate Service Centers (ISCs) school codes indicate the type of program and the remaining two digits are sequential:

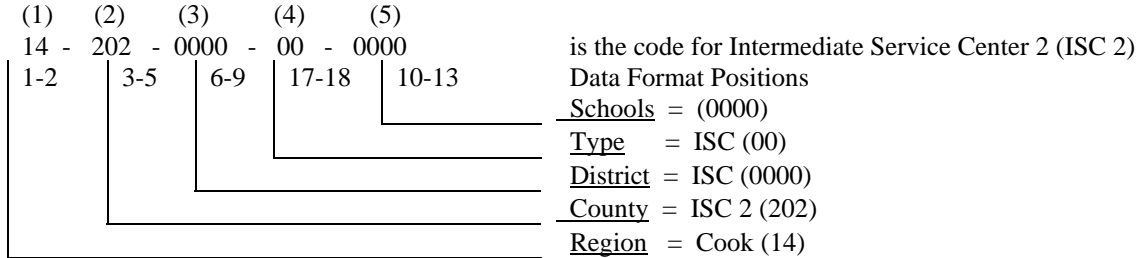
- 0-High School
- 1-Middle/Junior High School
- 2-Elementary School
- 3-Special School
- 4-Area Vocational School
- 6-Special Education Cooperative School
- 9-Regional School

### ROE and ISC School Codes

- If the first two digits are:
- 91 = Schools not assigned to Another Category
  - 92 = Alternative Programs
  - 93 = Safe School Programs
  - 94 = Pre-Kindergarten School Programs
  - 95 = ALOP (less than full day)

# KEY TO CODING: INTERMEDIATE SERVICE CENTERS

Category 0 contains only Intermediate Service Centers (ISC) records. ISCs in Illinois are identified by a unique code. This code is a combination of 11 numbers. The last four numbers identify the particular school operated by the ISC. The ISC district record will be 0000.



- (1) Region Code: A code of 2 numbers, ISCs are assigned a region code of 14 for those in suburban Cook and 15 for the one in Chicago.
- (2) ISC Code: A code of 3 numbers, ISCs are assigned a unique county code. (See below the RCDT conversion of ESCs numbers to ISCs numbers)
- (3) District Code: A code of 4 numbers, ISCs are assigned a district code of 4 zeros.
- (4) Type Code: A code of 2 numbers, ISCs are assigned a type code of 2 zeros.

- (5) School Code: A code of 4 numbers assigned to the school. ISCs are assigned 4 zeros in the school position of the district record. The first two digits of the school code begin with a 93 for Safe School Programs operated by the ISC, the remaining two digits are sequential.

If ISCs contract out Safe School Programs, a school code will not be present. A marker in position 19 of the CDS File is used to indicate contracted services (0 = None, 1 = Combination of Alternative and Safe Schools, 2 = Alternative School, 3 = Safe School).

Currently, there are 4 Intermediate Service Centers, but ISC 3 has a waiver. The following is a conversion of the previous Educational Service Centers (ESCs) to Intermediate Service Centers (ISCs).

**Intermediate Service Center 1 (ISC 1)** - previously Educational Service Center 3 (ESC 3)

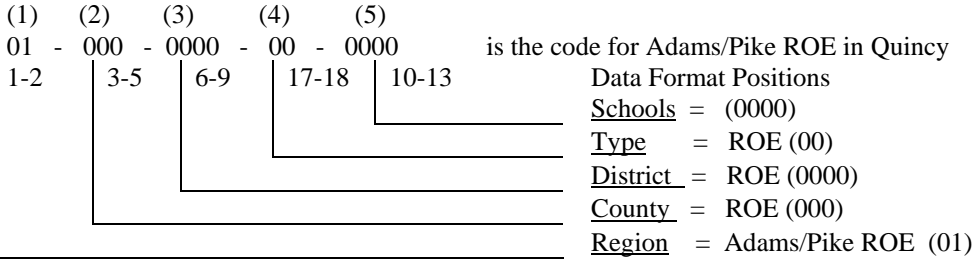

# KEY TO CODING: REGIONAL OFFICES OF EDUCATION

Category 1 contains only records for Regional Offices of Education (ROE). Appearing in the school position of the ROE record will be 0000. ROEs in Illinois are identified by a unique code. This code is a combination of 15 numbers. The first 11 numbers of the code identify the Regional Office of Education. Appearing in the school position of the entity record will be 0000.



- (1) Region Code: A code of 2 numbers, from 01-57 for the 45 Regional Offices of Education. Each region is made up of one or more of the 102 Illinois counties. (Region codes are listed in this document for reference purposes.)
  - (2) County Code: A code of 3 numbers, ROEs are assigned a county code of 3 zeros.
  - (3) District Code: A code of 4 numbers, ROEs are assigned a district code of 4 zeros.
  - (4) Type Code: A code of 2 numbers, ROEs are assigned a type code of 2 zeros.

- (5) School Code: A code of 4 numbers assigned to the school. ROEs are assigned a school code of 4 zeros.
