#### **GOALS**


**Every child** in each public school system in the State of Illinois deserves to attend a system wherein...

- All kindergartners are assessed for readiness.
- Ninety percent or more of third-grade students are reading at or above grade level.
- Ninety percent or more of fifth-grade students meet or exceed expectations in mathematics.
- Ninety percent or more of ninth-grade students are on track to graduate with their cohort.
- Ninety percent or more of students graduate from high school ready for college and career.
- All students are supported by highly prepared and effective teachers and school leaders.
- Every school offers a safe and healthy learning environment for all students.



#### The Whole Child

A child within an ecology of multiple and interconnected parts





#### IL ePlan

Consolidate and streamline the federal grant application and management process to reduce the burden on grantees and support holistic service to students



#### IL ePlan

- Supports planning and grant management
  - Takes multiple funding sources into consideration
  - Conducive to meeting each student's needs

- Will help ISBE understand each grantee holistically
  - Improved technical assistance grounded in equity



## IL ePlan: 3 Phases

- Phase 1: Consolidated District Plan (FY2020)
  - Consolidated plan for 12 federal grants
- Phase 2: Interactive Dashboard (FY2021)
  - Enable access to ISBE data systems on a single platform
- Phase 3: Consolidated District Application (FY2021)
  - Consolidated application for 12 federal grants



## Consolidated District Plan (CDP)

Consolidated **plan**for federal grant funds to
provide holistic service to students



#### **CDP**

- First phase of the IL ePlan
- Includes twelve federal grants
  - Answer one set of planning questions
  - Coordination of district admin managing federal grants
  - Engagement with stakeholders across federal grants
- Opens in eGMS for fiscal year 2020 grants on February 19, 2019

## How will the CDP support my district?

- Opportunity for supporting children holistically
- Single plan for multiple funding sources
- Opportunity for district collaboration across student support offices (e.g., EL, SPED, Title)
- Opportunity for engaging multiple groups of stakeholders in district on use of federal funds
- Opportunity for conversations with stakeholders across multiple federal funding sources
- Opportunity to coordinate with local and state funds to prioritize student needs



## What to expect on CDP?

- Summary of district's needs assessment
- Stakeholder engagement
- Non-public consultation info (except for Title III)
- Plan to support students' academic and linguistic development
- Plan to support teachers' professional development
- Plan to support parents



### What the CDP is not?

- Not a grant application
- Not a guarantee that federal funds will be awarded
- Not a tool for reporting on existing grants
- Not an instrument for planning/reporting expenses
- Not for documenting use of local or state funds
- Not a report of required federal or state services
