What's Going Well

PROGRAMMATIC

- Instructional model/practice shift
- Aligned grading scales and rubrics with competencies
- Multiple pathways created for greater student success
- Strong proficiency scales
- Adapted competencies PK –12
- Teachers supporting teachers with training/PD

STUDENT-CENTERED

- Successfully de-tracked courses allowing for greater inclusion
- High student agency, engagement, growth
- Strong parent and community support
- Enhanced real-world relevance for students
- More personalized and flexible learning for students
- Immediate and meaningful feedback



OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH

PROGRAMMATIC

- Advising/guidance challenges
- CBE expansion (subjects/grade levels)
- Promoting connections between subjects
- Additional PD and resources
- Greater staff buy-in
- Shift in educator practice and philosophy
- Alignment with traditional grading system

STUDENT-CENTERED

- Student achievement data not reflective of CBE efficacy
