

Task 00:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Present the primary task to the student. Say: "Here are a pencil, a paper clip, and a ruler." (The ruler should be 12 inches long.) "Which one is the shortest?"• Point to each option and say: "The pencil," "The paper clip," "The ruler" <p>The student receives a score of 4 for a correct response. If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, repeat the primary task <i>only once</i> exactly as it appears. If the student responds correctly after the second presentation of the primary task, the student receives a score of 4. If the student <u>again</u> chooses an incorrect answer or does not respond, move to Level 3.</p>	4
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Say the general prompt to the student: "Here are a crayon and a stapler. The crayon is the shorter object."• Re-present the primary task and answer options. <p>The student receives a score of 3 for a correct response. If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, move to Level 2.</p>	3
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Indicate the correct answer and re-present the primary task and answer options. <p>The student receives a score of 2 for a correct response. If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, move to Level 1.</p>	2
<p>If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly at Level 2, the student receives a score of 1.</p>	1
