<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Present the primary task to the student. Say: “Read this passage with me. ‘Kiana Gets a Pet: Kiana wanted a pet of her own. Her brother had a hamster. Kiana thought a cat would be nicer than a hamster. Kiana’s father took her to the animal shelter to adopt a cat. She saw a small gray cat sitting quietly in a cage. That was the cat she wanted! She named the cat Smoke.’ Which of these is a character in this passage?”• Point to each option and say: “Kiana,” “A cage,” “An animal shelter” <p>The student receives a score of 4 for a correct response. If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, repeat the primary task <i>only once</i> exactly as it appears. If the student responds correctly after the second presentation of the primary task, the student receives a score of 4. If the student <u>again</u> chooses an incorrect answer or does not respond, move to Level 3.</p>	4
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Turn the page to provide the general prompt.• Re-present the primary task and answer options. <p>The student receives a score of 3 for a correct response. If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, move to Level 2.</p>	3
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Indicate the correct answer and re-present the primary task and answer options. <p>The student receives a score of 2 for a correct response. If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, move to Level 1.</p>	2
<p>If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly at Level 2, the student receives a score of 1.</p>	1

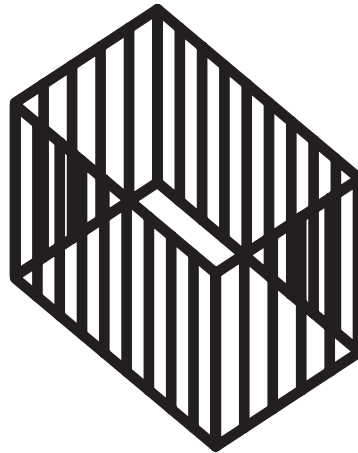

Kiana Gets a Pet

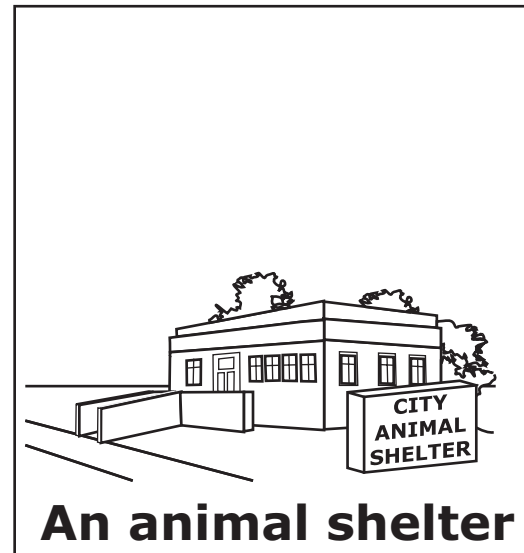
