Part One Item Summaries – for each accommodation, a pie chart of the numerical ratings assigned and a list of reasons given from respondents who did not use the accommodation; also pie chart results for five hypothetical questions regarding translated directions, translated glossaries, and vocabulary lists

Part One Ratings - Grade by ELP – a page of data for each accommodation showing the question posed (top), a set of stacked bar charts for each grade level depicting the ratings assigned by English language proficiency level (middle), the range of response counts among stacks (left), and a line chart of the average rating by ELP (right)

Part Two Compiled Responses – categorized comments to the following

- Which ELL accommodations would you have liked to provide, but were not able? Give a brief reason why you were not able.
- What are your thoughts/comments regarding each accommodation?
- What additional ELL accommodations would you like to be available?
- Three questions about native language proficiency levels and instruction.
