

FAMILY NAMES

Performance Standard 28D.A

Draw a family tree using the target language accordingly:

- *Knowledge*: Understand the vocabulary needed to identify family members.
- *Comprehension*: Understand the relationship among family members and how they are related.
- *Communication*: Convey the correct order of family members. Explain family tree (in English).

Procedures

1. *In order to use the target language to present information, concepts and ideas for a variety of purposes to different audiences (28D)*, students should experience sufficient learning opportunities to develop the following:
 - Label familiar items (e.g., family members, classroom objects, and pets).
2. Provide each student a copy of the “Family Names” task sheet and. Have students review and discuss the assessment task and how the rubric will be used to evaluate their work.
3. Practice making a family tree with necessary vocabulary to ask and express names.
4. Provide a word bank on the board with terms of 10 relatives, including grandparent, parent, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, male and female cousins.
5. Give each student a piece of blank paper and give the following instructions:
 - a. Draw a family tree.
 - b. Label yourself and at least 10 relatives in the target language.
 - c. The tree may be real or fictional, but should include all the persons mentioned. Under each label the student should write the proper name of the person.
6. Students should explain their tree (in English).
7. Evaluate each student’s presentation based on total items correct using the Foreign Language Rubric. Add each student’s scores to determine the performance level:
 - *Knowledge*: 4 = 9 - 10 correct, 3 = 7 - 8 correct, 2 = 5 - 6 correct, 1 = 1 - 4 correct,
 - *Comprehension*: Understood relationship between relatives.
 - *Communication*: Correctly identified individuals and explained family tree.
