Performance Standard 28C.C

Demonstrate knowledge of passages of a script accordingly:

- *Knowledge*: Know the vocabulary and language structures needed to read a written passage in familiar target language and answer questions about it.
- *Comprehension*: Respond with understanding, facility, and exceedingly clear, and natural pronunciation.
- *Communication*: Read aloud a passage of a script and answer oral questions about the content. Use the appropriate strategies for reading the script and answering questions about it.

Procedures

1. *In order to understand written passages in the target language (28C)*, students should experience sufficient learning opportunities to develop the following:
 - Use cognates to decode meaning of a passage.
 - Recognize repeating patterns in the target language.
2. Have students review and discuss the assessment task and how the rubric will be used to evaluate their work.
3. Distribute an age- and stage-appropriate passage to each student.
4. Have each student read the selection and have them demonstrate understanding by asking them questions.
5. After each student completes the reading, ask him/her questions about the passage.
6. Evaluate each student's performance using the Foreign Language Rubric as follows and add the scores to determine the performance level:
 - *Knowledge*: Vocabulary and language structures were used to read a written passage in familiar target language and answer question about it
 - *Comprehension*: Responses showed understanding.
 - *Communication*: Strategies were complete, appropriate and correct.
