

## GRAPHIC GEOGRAPHY

### Performance Standard 29E.E

Describe geographical features of an area where the target language is spoken accordingly:

- *Knowledge*: Know at least 10 geographical features of an area where the target language is spoken.
- *Communication*: Use the appropriate strategies, maps, digital images, graphs and other geographical representations to present main idea about the geography of the area in English.
- *Response*: Speak clearly and with understanding and without hesitation.

### Procedures

1. *In order to understand geography of areas where the target language is spoken(29E)*, students should experience sufficient learning opportunities to develop the following:
  - Use maps, digital images, graphs or other geographical representations to describe and discuss the geographical features of an area where the target language is spoken (e.g., annual rainfall, climate, etc).
2. Have students review and discuss the assessment task and how the rubric will be used to evaluate their work.
3. Assign each student an area of a target language country where the language is spoken.
4. Have students use available resources to research information on the geographical environment of the assigned area.
5. Instruct students to use maps, digital images, graphs or other geographical representations to present their descriptions and discuss their findings in a 2-minute presentation to the class.
6. Evaluate each student's performance using the Foreign Language Rubric as follows and add each student's scores to determine the performance level:
  - *Knowledge*: Geographical information about the area was complete and accurate.
  - *Communication*: Presentational strategies were complete, appropriate and correct.
  - *Response*: Spoke clearly, with understanding and without hesitation.
