

CAREER SCRAPBOOK

Performance Standard 30B.E

Prepare a “career scrapbook” with pictures and descriptions of careers accordingly:

- *Knowledge*: know how the target language can be used in at least 10 careers; know the vocabulary and structures for writing 3-4-sentences describing those careers;
- *Comprehension*: use the appropriate strategies to present pictures and descriptions of at least 10 careers in a scrapbook; and
- *Communication*: respond with understanding and facility; use correct pronunciation and intonation.

Procedures

1. ***In order to use the target language to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of a variety of career options (30B)*** students should experience sufficient learning opportunities to develop the following:
 - Explore general career choices in which the target language can be used; and
 - Describe activities and characteristics of selected occupations and work places.
2. Have students review and discuss the assessment task and how the rubric will be used to evaluate their work.
3. Ask students to find a picture that illustrates each of 10 careers, format the project in a “career scrapbook,” and write brief descriptions in the target language for each of the 10 pictures.
4. (Optional) Have the students present their scrapbooks to the class.
5. Evaluate each student’s performance using the Foreign Language rubric as follows and add the scores to determine the performance level.
 - *Knowledge*: the information about the 10 careers was complete and correct; the vocabulary and structures for conveying the information were complete and correct.
 - *Comprehension*: executed the task with understanding; presented the information without hesitation and used natural sounding pronunciation and intonation.
 - *Communication*: presentation strategies were complete, appropriate and correct.

Time Requirements

- Two to three days homework researching the information and preparing the scrapbook
- Two minutes per presentation (optional)

- Access to library or Internet
- Pictures or visuals that depict careers to mount on sheets of paper
