

WANT AD

Performance Standard 30B.G

Students will compose want ads for jobs. The ad will include the preparation required for the job and activities and duties the applicant will be required to perform accordingly:

- *Knowledge*: know the vocabulary needed for career orientation;
- *Comprehension*: understand spoken and written cues; and
- *Communication*: use appropriate strategies and structures.

Procedures

1. *In order to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of a variety of career options (30B)* students should experience sufficient learning opportunities to develop the following:
 - Describe the preparation for and activities of some careers in which the target language can be used.
2. Have students review and discuss the assessment task and how the rubric will be used to evaluate their work.
3. Students will have the requisite background information about a variety of careers in which the target language is used.
4. The students will prepare want ads that describe the preparation for and activities for three different jobs, including the preparation required for the job and activities and duties the applicant will be required to perform. Each ad will consist of five sentences.
5. Dictionaries may be used when writing the want ad.
6. Evaluate each student's work using the Foreign Language Rubric as follows and add the scores to determine the performance level:
 - *Knowledge*: knew vocabulary and structures for a classified advertisement.
 - *Comprehension*: understood vocabulary and cultural context.
 - *Communication*: used appropriate structures and styles.
