Why are we doing this?

Recent Reform Legislation

- Senate Bill 7 requires "...an instrument to provide feedback from, at a minimum, students in grades 6 through 12 and teachers on the instructional environment within a school..."
- Revised report card statute requires "2 or more indicators from any school climate survey developed by the State"
- PERA requires "(o)ne or more instruments to provide feedback to principals on the instructional environment within a school."





Illinois 5Essentials Survey Use

The survey <u>will</u> be used for:

School improvement planning

Providing a more robust picture of school performance on report card beyond test scores The survey <u>will not</u>be used for:

Identifying respondents

(responses are completely anonymous)

Personnel decisions

(guidelines established for appropriate use of survey data as a <u>goal setting</u> component in evaluation)



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

- 4. You will be entered into the survey.


