## Ramadan Waiver Available

- Schools can serve reimbursable non-congregate meals/snacks to students fasting during Ramadan
- Schools must complete waiver request in WINS
- Students must be in attendance at the school on the day the congregate meals/snacks are offered.
- Waiver request requires date range and a brief description of process to assure accurate meal counts.
- Parent/guardian template letter available to download

#### FOOD DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

#### Annual Order Period Set to Open Jan. 13

The School Year 2025-26 Annual Order Period opens Monday, Jan. 13, and closes Friday, March 7, 2025. The three spending options include USDA Foods, DOD Fresh, and diversion to processors.

The diversion to processors option will close in the Illinois Commodity System (ICS) the week of Feb. 24-28, so that ISBE can compile truck loads. It will re-open March 3-7 for final changes. All diversion to processor requests are due by March 7.

Please refer to the ICS Instructions for step-by-step instructions on placing an order.

#### Additional DOD Funds Available for SY 24-25

The state has additional DOD funds available for school districts participating in the Food Distribution Program. You may request funds by following the procedures below:

- 1. Please spend your allotted DOD funds before requesting additional funds.
- 2. Email Paula Williams at pawillia@isbe.net to request additional funds
- 3. Additional funds will be added in increments of 20% of your SY 25 Beginning PAL Balance. For example, if your Beginning PAL Balance was \$20,000, we will add \$4,000.
- 4. If you use all additional funds, you can request more at that time, following this same process.

#### Meals During E-Learning/Remote Days

It is a good time to remind districts about the rules and recommendations learning/remote learning for any unproviding meals during e-learning days anticipated school closure (COVID-19, as we experience colder temperatures fire, flooding, weather related (heat, and winter weather.

Providing meals during e-learning days is not required. However, providing meals can be an important part of a student's day, regardless of whether instruction is in person or via electronic means. As such, districts are encouraged to offer meals to all enrolled students during e-learning days to the extent practical and possible and according to the individual needs of each student.

If a district or school switches to ecold, snow), strikes, etc.), the district may offer meals to all enrolled students. To receive federal reimburse-

ment, the school district must submit a waiver request through the Web-Based Illinois Nutrition System (WINS) and may offer non-congregate meals to all enrolled students under the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program. Meals offered must continue to meet the federal program requirements. Districts must continue to charge, track,

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and claim meals provided by individual student eligibility. CEP approved sites must track and claim meals daily.

For the waiver process, log into IWAS and then WINS. On the left side of your dashboard, click "Waivers" under the "Sponsor Tasks" tab. Start by clicking the blue "Apply New Waiver" button and select the Waiver Type. These waivers should be completed prior to the day(s) necessary if possible. Instructions are available on the Waivers and Public Notices webpage.



#### Chart 1: Summary of Required Minimum Annual Training Requirements for School Nutrition Employees

Job Category	Annual Training Requirements*
Directors	12 hours
Managers	10 hours
All Other Staff (working 20 hours or more per week)	6 hours
Part-Time Staff (working less than 20 hours per week)	4 hours
Mid-year hires in all categories (January 1, or later)	One-half of training requirement for each job category
Temporary and acting employees, substitutes, and volunteers	Any annual training requirements are at the discretion of the State agency and may be required within 30 days of start date

\*Annual training requirements apply to the 12 months between July 1 and June 30.


