Thanks</p>	<p>If the student is a Non-resident Student that is paying tuition to your district, then your district would be the Home and Serving School and would be removed from the ASE count.</p>

<p>We have a few students that were at a Detention Center. We are going to use code Detention Center, however, I wondered about the April 14th deadline to have Detention Data Submitted. To date, the Services tab for these students do not show Detention Data. Do I reach out to them or is this something they do enter but we don't see?</p>	<p>If you know that your district had a student in a Detention center on 10/1 or 3/1, and they do not show up in the EBF verification screen, you can contact the detention center and ask them to add the record.</p>
<p>EL information is due prior to April 14,2023? Is this Correct. I see there was a March 1st Snapshot</p>	<p>EL information for TBE and TPI student is due on April 14</p>
<p>Is homeless student data used in EBF?</p>	<p>No</p>
<p>Will there be any changes to the EBF to special education cooperatives or will it be the same amount as in the past few years?</p>	<p>Only if there is a change to the member districts.</p>

How do we verify special education student counts between SIS and ISTAR? The EBF verification page does not have a category for SPED students.	You will need to work with your ISTAR staff.
I tried looking at our Evidence Based Funding Public District Verification screen, but when I go to that part of SIS, I get a warning stating "Your district can not currently view Evidence Based Funding (EBF) enrollment counts." would this be a permission issue for me or a district issue	You must have Admin access to view this screen, if you have View only SIS access you will not be able to see it.
When is the enrollment date due by?	All Data for EBF is due on April 14th
Was is the recommended procedure for the enrollment of students participating in an ALOP program? Our cooperating agency is asking the district to unenroll on March 1st for the March 1st count and the re-enroll the students on March 2nd. This process creates an issue reconciling attendance for the remainder of March, April, May, and June. Could these students be enrolled as a .9 for the district and .1 for the ALOP?	<p>If your district has made an agreement with the ROE to provide them with 3/1 EBF funding instead of Tuition.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Exit the Student on the last day of February.</li> <li>2.Enroll the student on 3/1 with the ROE as Serving and PDA set to 100%</li> <li>3.Re-Enroll the student on 3/2 in their regular enrollment</li> </ol> <p>This will transfer all EBF ASE to the ROE for 3/1, this includes EL funding though EBF.</p>
Can you repeat the info for Oct1 vs Sept 30 enrollment? Technically wouldn't Oct 1 enrollment be zero for everyone?	Because Oct 1st is on a Saturday this year, if you exited a student on the last day of September, you should contact this SIS support team to change the exit date to Oct 1st.
Do attendance days factor into the calculation?	No
Is there written documentation regarding the ALOP enrollment for March 1st mentioning only needing to be enrolled for one day on March 1st?	No

Where does EBF Low-income information come from	EBF low-income data is provided to ISBE annually by the Illinois Department of Human Services. It consists of students who receive services from one or more of the following programs: Medicaid, CHIP, TANF or SNAP.
How should students coming to us from another school be coded. We are their serving but not home school.	If another school district is transferring a student to you, they would be the home school and your school would be the serving school. If this is about a student who is paying tuition to attend your school, then your district would become the home and serving. But this means that the parent/guardian has taken on the financial burden of educating their student.
I have a student who is enrolled at our school, served at another. Recently, he was transferred to a juvenile detention center. According to what I just heard, I do NOT exit him while at DOC, correct?	Correct, If you are the Home/Resident District you will not exit or change the serving school for student while they are in a detention center.
EL information is due prior to April 14,2023? Is this Correct. I see there was a March 1st Snapshot	All Data for EBF is due on April 14th
