

- Student List Reports are <u>not</u> available (for download) this year since data are not considered final until published reports are posted.





- Click on Assessment Correction.
- 3. Click on PARCC.
- 4. Click on Step 1: Edit Assessment Correction.
- 5. Enter SID and one of the following: Last Name, First Name, or Date of Birth.
- 6. Click Search.
- 7. Click Edit on the test(s) you need to update (ELA/L and Math are separate).
- 8. Click Edit and make the needed updates (e.g. entering RNVTA codes, etc.).
- 9. Click Submit.

Release of SAT Scores

- In College Board's Reporting Portal, scores began to become available to students beginning on Monday, May 8, 2017, and to educators beginning on Monday, May 15, 2017.
- Data aggregations in College Board's Portal may not match accountability aggregations due to the following reasons:
 - Educators have access to scores for only the students who tested at their school using their school's test center code, regardless of the student's home school.
 - Data for cancelled scores are <u>not</u> available in College Board's Score Reporting Portal but will be accessible in ISBE's SIS for accountability reporting purposes.



SAT Scores Training Workshops





- Performance enhancements less "spinning"
- Added paused and in progress test attempts
- Fixed "Enrolled in Home School/District On or Before May 1" status
- SIS ID is now displayed on the grids instead of the vendor internal id
- Reasons not saving when grid was in responsive mode
- Better error messages
- Several one off data issues resolved or under investigation


