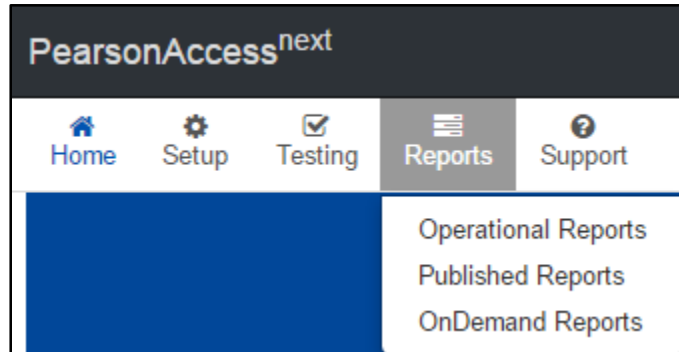
# PARCC OnDemand Reports in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> (PAN)

- The “ONDEMAND ADMIN REPORT ACCESS” role in PAN allows users to view “OnDemand Reports” for completed student scale score data as soon as it becomes available.
- Who has role? How to get role?
- New this year: “OnDemand Reports” are available to both the Responsible School and to the Testing School.
- Student List Reports are not available (for download) this year since data are not considered final until published reports are posted.



# PARCC OnDemand Reports in PAN

- Starting on May 12, 2017, users with the “ONDEMAND ADMIN REPORT ACCESS” role were able to access OnDemand Reports and Student List Reports in PAN.

# Release of SAT Scores

- In College Board's Reporting Portal, scores began to become available to students **beginning on Monday, May 8, 2017**, and to educators **beginning on Monday, May 15, 2017**.
- Data aggregations in College Board's Portal may not match accountability aggregations due to the following reasons:
  - Educators have access to scores for only the students who tested at their school using their school's test center code, regardless of the student's home school.
  - Data for cancelled scores are not available in College Board's Score Reporting Portal but will be accessible in ISBE's SIS for accountability reporting purposes.

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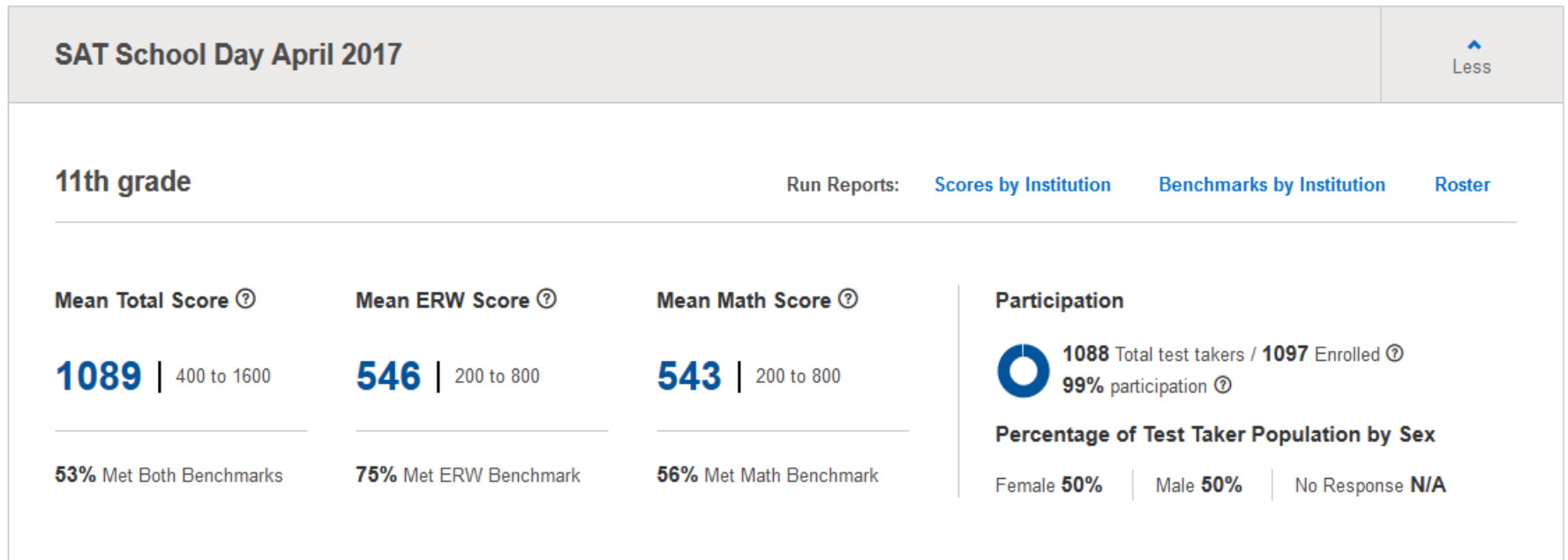

# Reviewing scores in the College Board's K-12 Assessment Portal

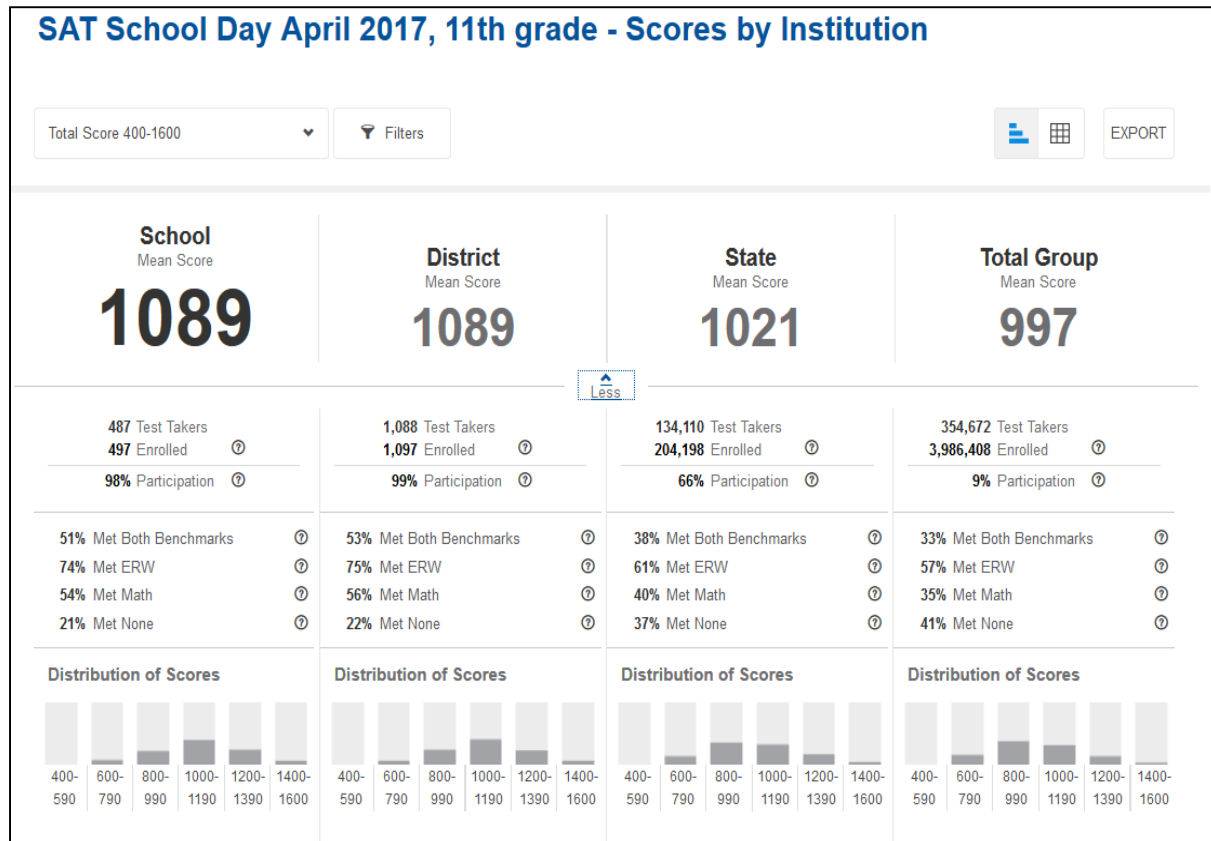

# SAT Scores Training Workshops

## ILLINOIS SCIENCE ASSESSMENT (ISA)

This Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) page will be updated as information becomes available. The ISA is *not* an alternate assessment. Students who participate in the DLM-AA alternate assessment will be assessed in science in grades 5, 8, and 11.

In compliance with federal testing requirements, Illinois will administer a science assessment to students enrolled in a public school district in grades 5, 8 and once at the high school level. The high school assessment utilizes a course-based model with content aligned to Biology I. The assessment will be administered in an online format and is aligned to the Illinois Learning Standards for Science incorporating the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS), which were adopted in 2014.
