### **Preliminary Summative Designations**

- Letters to superintendents & principals went out on 6/30/2018 with preliminary identification of schools
  - Used 2017 data
  - A reduced set of indicators, particularly for K-8 schools
  - Those eligible for Comprehensive and Targeted supports only
- There is a possibility the rating could change

- Underperforming does not mean the whole school is underperforming, just that one or more subgroups' performance is on par with students who attend the lowest performing 5% of schools.



- Spring PSAT 2019 Ordering Please DO NOT place any exam orders in the College Board Test Ordering System for <u>Spring 2019 testing</u> related to Illinois High School Accountability testing, which includes:
  - PSAT 8/9 Grade 9
  - PSAT 10 Grade 10
  - SAT School Day Grade 11
- Fall 2018 PSAT and Spring 2019 PSAT 8/9 for 8th Grade ISBE is not reimbursing districts/schools for any Fall 2018 PSAT/NMSQT (grades 10 and 11, Fall 2018 PSAT 8/9 (grades 8 and 9) or Spring 2019 PSAT 8/9 (8th grade) tests. Administering these assessments will be a local decision and expense. ### IL School Code and ISBE Rules

- ISBE is in the process of updating the School Code. For now...
  - Placing high school accountability test scores on transcripts is no longer required.
    - Reference: Public Act 100-0222 (signed into law on 08/18/17)
       <u>www.ilga.gov/legislation/publicacts/fulltext.asp?Name=100-0222&print=true&write</u>
  - Taking the high school state accountability test remains a condition to receive a regular high school diploma.
    - Reference: "State goals and assessment" (105 ILCS 5/2-3.64a-5) Sec. 2-3.64a-5
- ISBE Rule defines grade 11 as follows: "grade 11" means the point in time when a student has earned the number of credits necessary for enrollment in grade 11, as determined by his or her school district.

### IL School Code and ISBE Rules

- Rules presented to the Board in September will allow students to be promoted to grade 12, even if they still need to test.
- An indicator in SIS will pre-ID students in grade 12 who still need to test.
- SIS will prevent a student who has not met the requirement from exiting the SIS enrollment as graduated.
- Rules will also establish a process to request a waiver of the graduation requirement (not the requirement to test) for a limited number of students.
  - Less than 1% of the graduating class (all students graduated that school year)
  - Above that, additional evidence required but still possible

### **Illinois Assessment of Readiness**

- ELA and Mathematics accountability test for students in grades 3-8.
- Data Recognition Corporation (DRC Maple Grove, MN) will be providing assessment services for IL schools.
- PARCC/New Meridian will provide the test forms for the next two years to ensure compatibility and continuity through the transition.





#### **Illinois Assessment of Readiness**

- The transition to a computer-adaptive assessment will be phased in over time.
- Meetings with DRC staff are just beginning.

#### **Illinois Assessment of Readiness**

- Final Test Window Dates Have Not Been Determined.
  - Definitely will not begin before March 4, 2019
  - Unless necessary, will not extend past April 26, 2019
  - Always select the shortest testing window practicable
- Paper tests will be an accommodation option but as the goal is to transition to a computer adaptive test, the default is online administration.



#### **DLM-AA: Special Education Cooperatives**

- Enrolling students in SIS should be completed in the following manner while we transition to the new RCDTs codes for Special Education Cooperatives:
  - Home School-where the student resides
  - Serving School-physical location of the program
  - Service Provider-Special Education Cooperative school level code



#### **DLM-AA: Special Education Cooperatives**

- For DLM, any new programs that were created will be uploaded to DLM.
- Users in the system will need to have their organization changed to the new program if applicable.
- Please update this information prior to the data lockdown.



#### **DLM-AA: Pre-ID**

- Students in grades 3 through 11 will be assessed in 2018-19. This includes 9th and 10th grade.
- Students in grades 3 through 11 will test in ELA and math. This includes 9th and 10th grade.
- Students in grades 5, 8, and 11 will <u>also</u> test in Science
- Must have a school level RCDTs (no longer allowing any district level code: 0000, 6100, 6000)

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#### **DLM-AA: Pre-ID**

- Uploads to DLM will begin late October, early November.
- Students must have a DLM Pre-ID in order for them to be uploaded to DLM.
- If a student's previous assessment record was DLM, then the student already has a DLM Pre-ID.
- Students must have an IEP to take the DLM.

## **WIDA Braille Update**

ACCESS Braille grades 1-5 are currently transcribed using literary math (for example, use the words "divided by" instead of "+"). Grades 6-8 and 9-12 have some algebra and formulas that do not lend themselves to this approach. Based upon recommendations, cluster 6-8 will be available in UEB with Nemeth in the 2018-19 administration while grade cluster 9-12 will be added next year in **UEB** with Nemeth.
