Release of SAT Scores

- On May 3, 2017, some students were able to see their test scores in College Board's Portal for a brief period. Only students whose scores were already available were temporarily visible.
- The scores were valid and will not change, however they were removed since full score reports were not yet available.
- Students would have seen their Total Score and their scores for the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math sections.
- These students will again be able to access their scores as well as their full score report beginning on Monday, May 8, 2017.



Release of SAT Scores

- Scores will begin to become available to students in College Board's Reporting Portal beginning on Monday, May 8, 2017, and to educators beginning on Monday, May 15, 2017.
- Look for an email from College Board with Educator Access and Student Access Directions and refer to additional score reporting resources on the College Board website.
- Educators will have access to scores for the students who tested at their school using their school's test center code, regardless of the student's home school.
- Data for cancelled scores are <u>not</u> available in College Board's Score Reporting Portal but will be accessible in ISBE's SIS for accountability reporting purposes.



Release of SAT Scores: Important Notes

- Some scores will be released later than the week of May 8, 2017, for reasons that include participation in the later accommodations testing window or on the makeup testing date, late receipt of answer sheets, missing information on the answer sheet, or other exception conditions that require additional attention.
- If scores are not available, students should check the Portal periodically for updates. The Portal will update daily as additional individual student scores are released.
- All data in the College Board Portal are preliminary for internal use. Performance levels have not been determined yet, so these data cannot be used for accountability purposes at this time.



SAT Scores Training Workshops

- College Board will provide free training workshops on the Score Reporting Portal in June 2017.
- These workshops will provide district and school leaders access to the Online Score Reporting Portal, an understanding of how to navigate and use the features of the portal, and a step-by-step walk through of the exam results and connections to resources and best practice tools for incorporating the data back into schools. In addition, an overview of Khan Academy and the steps students can take to view and link their scores from their College Board accounts will also be provided.
- Each location will have a morning and afternoon session with the same material covered at both workshops.
- Morning sessions are from 9:00-11:30 a.m. and afternoon sessions are from 1:00-3:30 p.m.



2016-17 ISA

The Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) test window ran from March 1, 2017 to April 28, 2017. At the close of business (5 PM) on Friday, April 28, 2017, ISBE Teach and ISBE Learn systems were brought down to begin the post test phase. For those that did not complete testing, document the situation and include a plan for corrective action to ensure compliance for the following years. The test windows for 2018 and 2019 remain all of March and April and will span March 1 to April 30. Documentation should be submitted to your district test coordinator and filed. Do not send the information to ISBE at this time. ISBE will send formal letters to districts if a response is requested.


Stopping Sessions

- The final step when all students have completed/submitted all units in a test session is to "Stop" the test session.
- "Stopping" the test session releases the student responses for scoring.
- All students must be in "Complete" or "Marked Complete" status (BLUE) to be stopped
- You can "Stop" multiple/all sessions at once.
- Students who never started the session can be removed.



PARCC Rejected Student Tests

- Paper-Based Tests Only
- Paper tests have begun to be processed, so schools may begin to see "Rejected" tests in PAN.
- ISBE will monitor these daily and contact school staff if assistance is needed in resolving these.
- To view, go to "Testing" and select "Rejected Student Tests" then "Search/Show all results"




