

PARCC Test Score Results in PAN

- Student scores for PARCC are scheduled to start appearing in Pearson Access Next (PAN) on Friday, May 18. Scores will appear on a rolling basis.
- In PAN, select "Reports" then "OnDemand Reports."



 The PAN User Role needed to see these reports is called "ONDEMAND ADMIN REPORT ACCESS"

Note: Reports are not accessible if a User has <u>both</u> "ONDEMAND ADMIN REPORT ACCESS" <u>and</u> "ONDEMAND TEACHER REPORT ACCESS"




PARCC Test Score Results in SIS



PARCC Score Suppressions from Irregularity Reports

- Report Suppression Code/Action 5
 - Student will receive a score, but score will not be used for district/school accountability (by far the most common).
- Report Suppression Code/Action 1
 - Student will not receive a score.
- In both cases, student receives credit for participation (district/school accountability).





Call for Evaluators for 3-8 RFSP

- ISBE needs evaluators to review bids for the 3-8 assessment vendor who:
 - Can devote significant time to being a reviewer and who can prioritize meetings and deadlines. We must conduct this process quickly to have a contract in place before the school year. Each bid will require 8-16 solid hours to review, and 4-6 bids are anticipated. <u>All</u> evaluators must review all bids, and there is a 3 week deadline for initial reviews.
 - Have experience in assessment or curriculum development that is recent and substantial. In particular, nominees should have a <u>deep understanding of the Illinois Learning</u>
 Standards.
 - Have a strong technical understanding of assessment design and measurement principles, and assessment/measurement research. Evaluators must be able to read highly technical assessment bids and be able to *evaluate the technical merit* of the proposal.
 - Have no conflicts of interest* and have no apparent biases towards or against the prospective bidders.
 - Experience with <u>native language assessment development</u> specifically, and working with or representing diverse student populations strongly preferred.

Evaluators must be available in the desired time period, June 26 – July 13, for initial review, and must be able to commit the hours needed. In addition they must be available for additional webinar or conference calls to receive training and participate in post-evaluation meetings and vendor presentations.

- Any student who did not test but should have must indicate in SIS the reason for no valid test attempt (RNVTA).
- RNVTA codes are located at the link below: https://www.isbe.net/Documents/reason-no-valid-test-attmpt.pdf
- RNVTA descriptions have been updated and must be used correctly to indicate the reason why the student did not test. If one of the codes, based on the description, does not truly apply to the student, then a code 10 must be indicated.
- Only home districts are able to put in a valid RNVTA.
- All corrections must be completed by August 31, 2018.








SAT Assessment Correction in SIS

- Any student who tests must be included on the SAT Assessment Correction report in SIS so their scores will "have a place to land" when they arrive in July.
- In order to be included on the SAT Assessment Correction report in SIS, a student must have a "grade 11" SIS enrollment on April 10, 2018.
- Districts may adjust grade levels as needed in SIS so students are included.

1	Medically Exempt	Student (a) was hospitalized because of medical emergencies or procedures (e.g., because of a motor vehicle or other type of accident, surgery, psychiatric emergency) during the time of testing or (b) was participating in residential programs that provide psychological treatment or treatment for drug or alcohol abuse during the time of testing.					
2	Homebound	Student was homebound during the time of testing, and it was not feasible or appropriate for the student to be tested due to their medical condition.

Release of SAT Scores in College Board's Reporting Portal

- In College Board's Reporting Portal, scores became available to students beginning on Thursday, May 3, 2018, and will become available to educators beginning on Monday, May 21, 2018.
- Educators have access to scores for only the students who tested at their school using their school's test center code, regardless of the student's home school.
- As of May 8, 2018, more than 132,000 scores from the SAT School Day have been released to Illinois students via College Board's Reporting Portal.



Release of SAT Scores in College Board's Reporting Portal

- Scores for some students will be released later than May 3, 2018, due to:
 - Participation after April 10, 2018 (during the accommodations testing window or on the makeup testing date)
 - Late receipt of answer sheets
 - Missing information on answer sheets, or
 - Other exception conditions that require additional attention
- The Portal will update daily as additional individual student scores are released.
- All data in the College Board Portal are preliminary data for internal use.



Release of SAT Scores in College Board's Reporting Portal

- Data for students who tested with State-Allowed accommodations <u>are</u> available in College Board's Score Reporting Portal and will also be accessible in ISBE's SIS for accountability reporting purposes.
- Data for cancelled scores <u>are not</u> available in College Board's Score Reporting Portal but will be accessible in ISBE's SIS for accountability reporting purposes.

- ISBE is in the process of updating the School Code. For now...
 - Placing high school accountability test scores on transcripts is no longer required.
 - Reference: Public Act 100-0222 (signed into law on 08/18/17)

 - Taking the high school state accountability test remains a condition to receive a regular high school diploma.
 - Reference: "State goals and assessment" (105 ILCS 5/2-3.64a-5) Sec. 2-3.64a-5
- ISBE Rule defines "grade 11" and indicates students may not be promoted to grade 12 in SIS until they have taken the high school accountability test.
