The 38th annual Illinois Arts Education Week will be March 16-22, 2020. The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) and the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum (ALPLM) will partner for this year's contest in cooperation with the Illinois Art Education Association (IAEA). This exciting collaboration will create more visibility for young Illinois artists and their talent. The art contest reinforces the importance of the arts in the growth and development of all students.

PLEASE NOTE CONTEST CATEGORIES: Elementary (K-5), Middle (6-8), and High School (9-12). The judges will select a winner and five runners-up in each category. All 18 winners will have their artwork displayed in the ALPLM for one year. The ALPLM will recognize the winners on February 12, 2020. Museum entry is free on this day as it is Abraham Lincoln's birthday. All are welcome to attend!

One poster winner will be chosen by the judges from the three winners and featured on a poster to celebrate the arts during Illinois Arts Education Week. This winner will also be recognized at an ISBE Board meeting and a framed poster will be displayed in the Board office. The winners will also be recognized at the 2020 IAEA Fall Conference.

## ART CONNECTS HISTORY WITH THE FUTURE!

The art contest entries must meet the following criteria:

- Any Illinois student, grades K-12, public/private/home schooled is eligible to enter.
- ARTWORK MUST BE 11" X 14" AND VERTICAL FORMAT.
- Artwork must be 2-D and must be flat, NOT FOLDED.
   Please do not use chalk, glitter, or laminated items.
   If pencil is used, make sure it's dark enough to be reproduced. If entering photography or electronically created images, submit only a printed version for judging.
- All art must be the student's original work, not taken from another source. Do not use copyrighted images.
- No limit on colors used or number of entries per school.
- Please submit hard copy (actual artwork or print) to the address provided. For original artwork to be returned after the contest, please also include a self addressed envelope with the appropriate postage.
- Students must complete and securely attach the Authorization Form on the back of their entry.
- Theme for this year is LEADERSHIP IS AN ART! The imagery should reflect the theme, plus represent all five art areas (dance, media arts, music, theatre, and visual arts). Text is not necessary as the title/theme will be professionally typeset.
- Students should write a brief statement of how the theme relates to their entry on the back of their artwork.
- If the artwork is abstract, please mark the TOP with an "X" on the back.
