






How to locate Bilingual Ed. PDR in IWAS

Eligible Districts Required for PDR

- Annual bilingual data collection in IWAS
- IL Districts that received state and/or federal funding for EL services are required to complete PDR submission.
- Eligibility criteria since 2019: districts that received \$5,000 or more of state Evidence Based Funding (EBF) for EL services and/or Title III LIEP funding.
 - 2018-19 SY: 308 Districts
 - 2019-20 SY: 320 Districts



Eligible Districts for 2020 PDR

Funding Type Selection in PDR	2020 PDR Cohort SDs
State EBF for EL services only (\$5,000 or more) Federal Title III LIEPs only	80 SDs
State EBF for EL services (\$5,000 or more) and Federal Title III LIEP	229 SDs
Federal Title III LIEPs only	11 SDs
Total	320 SDs




2020 PDR Timeline and Resources






View Prior Year PDR
















PDR Submission to ISBE- Confirmation






PDR Submission Status







- After PDR submission to ISBE, District can't change the PDR.
- Contact ISBE to request PDR reset, if needing edit.
- ISBE returns the PDR to District.
- District edits PDR and resubmits to ISBE.
