## **MULTILINGUAL DEPARTMENT**

Under PA 98-0560 nonpublic schools may choose to participate in the State Seal of Biliteracy program to certify the attainment of a high level of proficiency, sufficient for meaningful use in college and a career, by a graduating public high school student in one or more languages in addition to English.

To participate in the program, the school must submit an application to ISBE <u>each year</u> and agree to adhere to all program requirements included in <u>23 III. Admin. Code Section 1.442</u> including:

- Designate at least one individual to serve as coordinator of the State Seal of Biliteracy Program
- · Participate in training approved by the State Board of Education prior to awarding the State Seal of Biliteracy
- Inform parents and students about the program by posting required information on the district's website, if the school maintains a website, and in the student handbook
- Utilize one or more of the allowed methods in Parts 1.442 (a) and (b) to evaluate students' qualifications for the State Seal of Biliteracy
- Schools may also choose to award the State Commendation toward Biliteracy to students who qualify following the methods in Part 1.442(c)(1) and (2)
- Maintain appropriate records in order to identify students who have earned the State Seal of Biliteracy and, if awarded, the State Commendation toward Biliteracy
- · Make the appropriate designations on the diploma and transcript of each student who earns the award, and
- Submit an annual report to ISBE no later than 30 days after the end of the school year
