

## **Activity 3.1 Sharing is Caring**

## **Activity Preview**

The following activity has been developed in conjunction with the learning plan called *Come Together:* Strategies for Improving Program Quality through the Incentive Funding Grant. This activity is supplemental to Module 2. Local Advisory and assesses the following learned skill: Identify key groups or individuals each quality indicator goal area could be shared with to improve program quality. In this activity, teachers will create a list of those key groups or individuals that can help implement the plan to improve aspects of program quality.

## **Directions**

- 1. Review Quality Indicators Preview Document
- 2. For each quality indicator, identify a group or individual that can help implement that indicator. (Examples: 1.4 Professional Development could be School Principal, 2.2 Student Career Experiences could be the school guidance department, 3.6 Career Recruitment and Development Activities could have a different community member that helps coach each team, etc.)
- 3. Discuss your findings with your small group once ready.

- 1. What is the value in "sharing" the responsibility of improving program quality?
- 2. What are the benefits of intentional planning through IFG v. planning without IFG in mind?
