

- <u>SIS Key Dates</u>
- The Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate is calculated based on Student Information System (SIS) data, specifically student enrollments and with proper identification of enrollment exit codes.
 - It is important that student information reported to SIS is accurate.
 - The Cohort Enrollment Exit Type Code provides an accurate measure of high school graduation data.
 - It is initially set to the student's general Enrollment Exit Type Code, but it can be updated (as appropriate) through the related online screens.
 - There are three categories -- Graduates, Non-Graduates, and Removed from Cohort -- that are used in calculating the Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate.
