

The Learning Institute designs & facilitates Model Core and Curricula training for professionals to implement in their agency.

Additionally, the Institute provides professional development opportunities, including model implementation Technical Assistance, Coaching, book studies and Communities of Practice. We "Walk Alongside" professionals as they acquire knowledge of the Model framework and skills. We scaffold professionals as they integrate Model elements into practices to "Become Ever Better".

Our Model framework is strengths based and utilizes observation and reflection to identify effectiveness in application of the Baby TALK Approach.

Mission

To positively impact child development by nurturing healthy and responsive relationships during the critical early years.

From a Technical Assistance (TA) Perspective:

TAs will "Come Alongside" program supervisors to create and implement your PI program through:

- Biweekly, monthly, or periodic collaborative meetings
- Individualized planning to identify program strengths and priorities
- Creating a framework to meet funder and model expectations
- Reflecting on goals, outcomes, and feedback for growth

From a Coaching Perspective:

TAs will "Come Alongside" your Program Coach as a Reflective partner to:

- Identify areas for growth based on internal program assessments (i.e., video, documentation, or observations)
- Support creation of goals through coaching "experiments"
- Reflect and discuss "how are you growing?" in your experiments
- Build professional reflective capacity

Our Timelines

TA Specialists are ready to begin collaborating with your program immediately.

We offer flexible scheduling frequency to provide personalized support based on your priorities.

Model Core trainings are held quarterly. One day overview trainings are available to support programs with staff hired between regular trainings.

Location

TA Specialists meet with programs virtually, inperson at your site, or in regional locations through program networking opportunities.

Trainings may be held virtually or in-person.


