Historical Context



ISBE + Ed Reports Partnered

Ed Reports provided multiple trainings for ISBE staff and agency leads to build capacity around defining quality curriculum.



Development of the CET

ISBE worked cross-departmentally to develop the Curriculum Evaluation Tool (CET).



ISBE Piloted the CET with 5% of districts

After the pilot, ISBE received feedback from participating districts and made adjustments to the CET.



ISBE +ROE Partnering

ISBE and the ROE are partnering to build capacity in districts around the different components of the CET.



Curriculum Evaluation Tool

- CET stands for **Curriculum Evaluation Tool**.
- The focus of the CET is on systems and processes within districts to ensure alignment with continuous improvement efforts, assessment, and best practices for ALL students.
- ISBE encourages districts to use this tool to help evaluate their curriculum, foster meaningful discussions, and make decisions about the selection of new materials as appropriate.

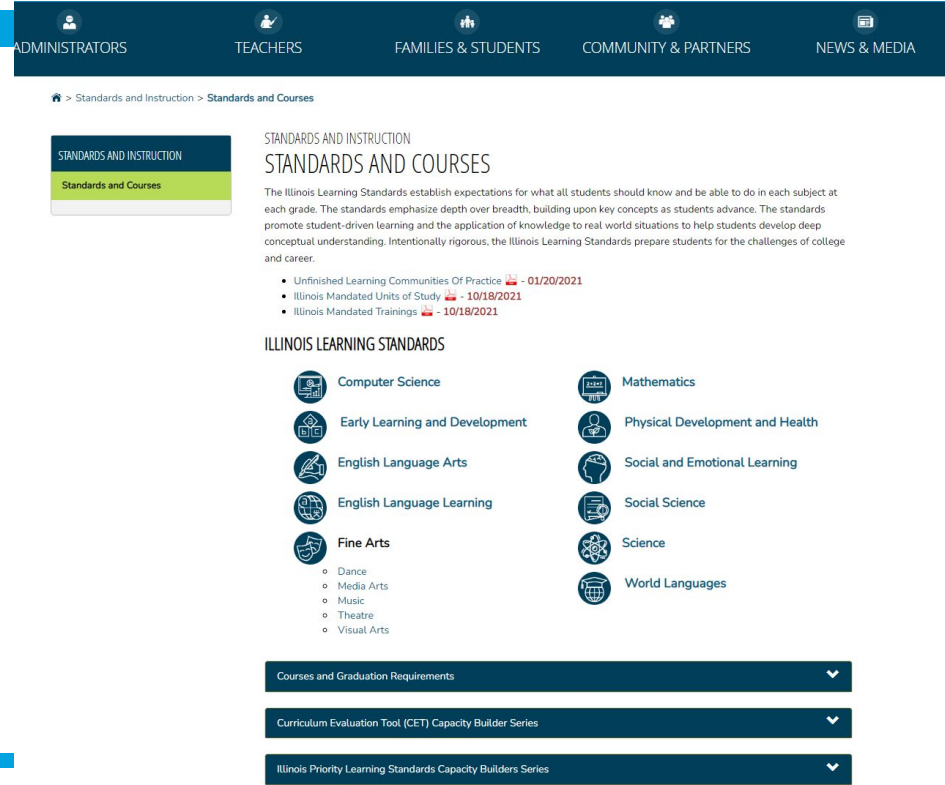
Intended use of the Curriculum Evaluation Tool

Reimbursement Logistics

Requirements

- All reimbursements will be on a first come first serve basis, districts can be reimbursed up to \$892 for expenses
 - Teacher stipends, sub pay etc.
- SD must have opted to participate in spring assessment testing (SY20/21)
- Must apply the CET to a Math or ELA curriculum
- All reimbursements forms must be completed before June 30, 2022

Recommendations

- While not required, ISBE encourages districts to work with their local ROE or ISC to complete the tool to help identify areas in which the ROE or ISC can provide additional supports through professional learning and aid in the selection of new curricular materials.



Reimbursement Logistics



1. Complete the [Certification of Use form](#).

Be prepared to share the following information:

- ROE/ISC information
 - Name, email etc.
- District Information
 - Region and name of district
- CET Data
 - Which subject area and grade band the CET was applied to
 - The name of the curricula the CET was applied to
- Capacity Building Event(s) Logistics
 - Dates, name, type of event, location of event
 - Number of PD hours, cost to participants, list of participants (name and role)



Reimbursement Logistics



2. Complete the CET Expense Reimbursement Form.
 - Keep track of your expenditures. Once your work is done, email the expense form and proof of purchases to Krissy Darm at kdarm@roe35.org.

Be prepared to input the following information:

- The month & year the work was completed
- Who completed the work
- The district(s) completing the work
- The date(s) of expenditures
- The activity and the expense
- An itemized receipt/proof of expenditures
