DQD Overview

- DQD is an interactive tool created by ISBE to provide feedback to Local Education Agencies (LEA) on the quality of submitted data
- DQD uses a series of audits and reasonability checks to flag potential data errors or discrepancies
- When audits are flagged, the DQD explains where and why the errors occurred, and how they can be addressed



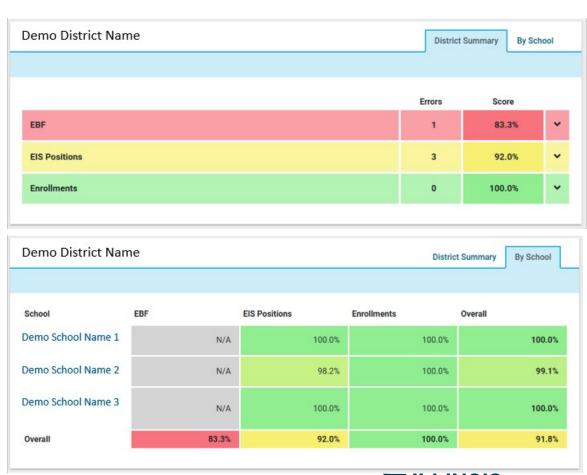
DQD Overview

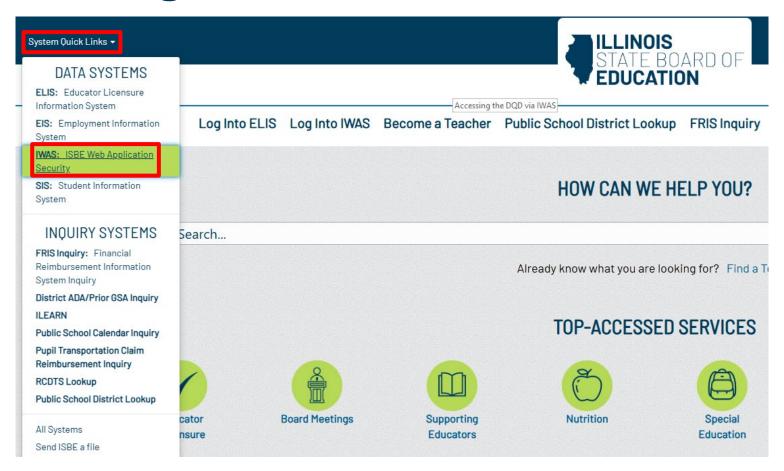
- The objective of the DQD is to ensure that each LEA has the most accurate data available for externally published reports
- ISBE recommends that LEAs use this tool regularly and especially after data is submitted and before <u>public data collection deadlines</u> have passed
- Once public data collection deadlines have passed, all data are considered final and may be used as-is on upcoming state reporting

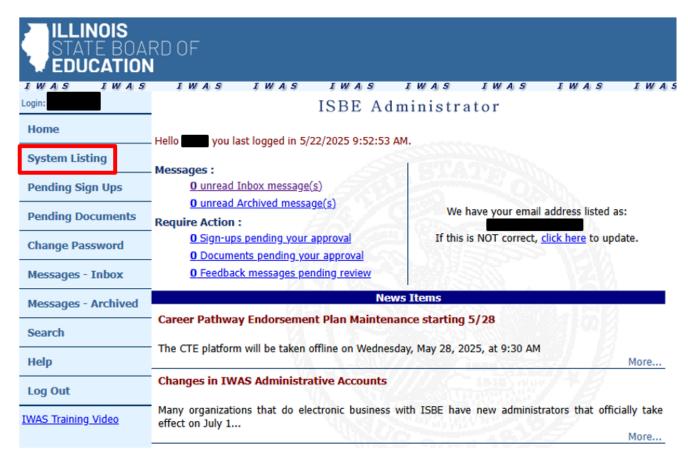
- Navigate to the ISBE home page (https://www.isbe.net/)
- Hover over System Quick Links
- Click on 'IWAS: ISBE Web Application Security' link





- Existing IWAS users enter Login Name and Password, click 'Log In'
- New users click 'Sign Up Now' to create an IWAS profile





Click 'System Listing' to access list of IWAS apps





- Click 'Data Quality Dashboard v2'
 - If this is not on your list of approved systems, click 'Want to Signup for Other Systems?' at the bottom of the screen and request access for the DQD

- The DQD shows the District Summary screen by default
- This screen shows a summary of all active audits
 - Please note that active audits change depending on upcoming data collection due dates
 - Please refer to the DQD Audit Schedule on the DQD landing page for a general outline of when each audit is active (subject to change)

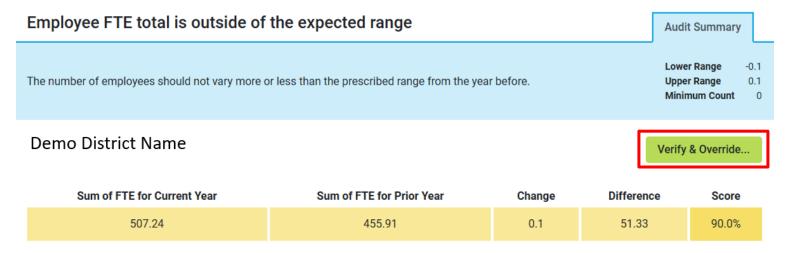

- The Audit Summary screen shows a description of the audit, how the audit is calculated, and how to address the audit
- Audits are either addressed in the source system (EIS, SIS etc.) or they are verified and overridden in the DQD
- Once an audit has been addressed, the DQD will reflect the change the next day



Navigating the DQD – Audit Summary

- Some audits can be addressed by verifying and overriding in the DQD
- In the demo example below, the district has entered accurate data however the audit is flagged as the difference in the current year's data compared to previous year's is large enough to require review

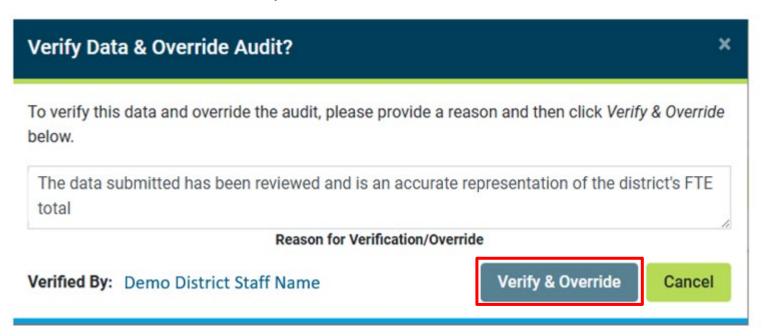


 In this instance, the district must review that the data is accurate and then click the 'Verify & Override' button



Navigating the DQD – Audit Summary

- The 'Verify Data & Override Audit?' window will appear
- The district must enter an explanation for why the audit is being overridden into the text box, then click 'Verify & Override'

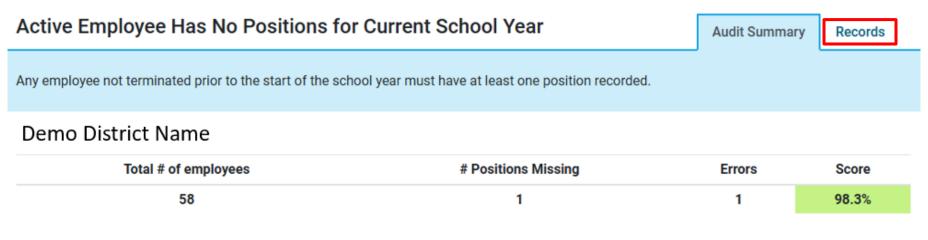


 The Audit Summary page will update to show the audit has been overridden, the flag will be removed the next day



Navigating the DQD – Records Tab

- Some audits are enabled with a 'Records' tab to show specifically where potential data errors exist
- Click the 'Records' tab to view datapoints



Navigating the DQD – Records Tab

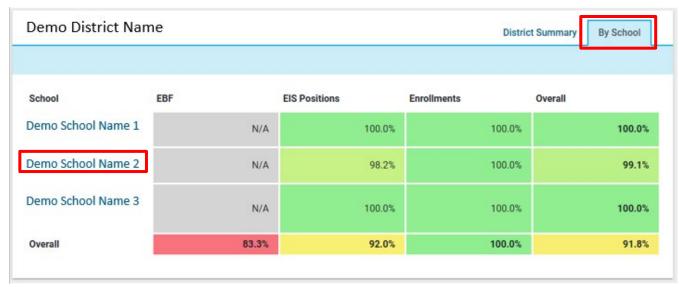
- The 'Records' tab displays the specific data records that contribute to the audit summary
 - Review these records in the source system to ensure they are correct and audits are addressed
 - In this example, the district must review the employee's EIS positions



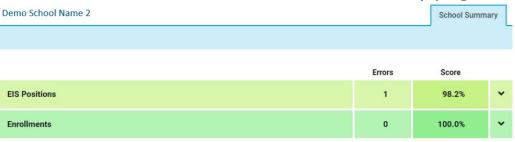
 Records can be downloaded to an Excel spreadsheet for easy use

Navigating the DQD - By School

 On the home screen of the DQD, the user can click the 'By School' tab to show a summary of audits by school



Each school name can be clicked to open the School Summary page,
 which functions the same as the District Summary page
