When should we be able to see data? my dashboard has nothing under academics. Nor do I have any of the explanation slides.	The explainer slide should be the first screen you see when entering the metric. If you are having issues accessing the metrics, please email mydashboard@isbe.net .
Would you please provide one more high-level description of how administrators might best use the new cohort-driven analysis tool?	Unlike the snapshot that shows trends, the cohort visualizations show us the performance of a particular cohort of students. Within the Progress tabs, in the cohort visualization, shifts in performance can be analyzed at the student group level, which is a more accurate reflection of performance and growth over time than annual snapshot data
Does this provide the specifics of the breakdown of the summative designation? In other words, can I as a principal know why I have the designation I do through use of the new reporting?	The summative designation details are scheduled to be released in the future. It is not currently available.
do regional safe schools have data access?	Not at this time.
Is the "Progress by Grade Tested Overtime" (Slide 9) available publicly to see and generate?	These visualizations are only within MDD at this time.
Is any of this data available to board users? For example, finances, etc.	Not at this time.
Will serving schools also be able to see assessment data, or just the home districts?	Depends on the metric. Serving entities get report card data but it's a limited amount of metrics. Email mydashboard@isbe.net and we'll look into the specifics.
Do we have to request additional access for these resources in the data dashboard? If not, when will it be live? Thank you.	New metrics are available now for district administrators. School admin and ROE will be gaining access shortly.

Will the visualizations include subgroup data: DL, EL, etc...	Subgroup details are included in the roster.
When will official IAR data from Spring 2023 be available on the Report Card?	Assessment information will be included in MDD after the Report Card release. Report Card IAR data is publicly released at the end of October.
Can you show how to track grade level IAR data over time?	There are a couple of ways – progress by report card allows drilling into particular grade performance changed over time, or you can look

	at grades by specific year within the progress by grade tested tab.
When will KIDS 22-23 data be available?	Assessment information will be included in MDD after the Report Card release.
How do you get to the explainer side? I do not see it on my end.	The explainer slide should be the first screen you see when entering the metric. If you are having issues accessing the metrics, please email mydashboard@isbe.net .
Are these reports downloadable?	The data within the roster is downloadable.
Will these reports ever be broken down by standard in addition to the demographics?	Contact the ISBE assessment team for inquiries about additional assessment data availability.
Do Special Education Cooperatives have access to My Data Dashboard?	Not at this time.
Will the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10 scores be added into the dashboard to follow the SAT cohort?	Not at this time. The question is if additional assessments within the suite will be included in the report card, as MDD provides deep dives for report card metrics.
Is the data already live for 22-23 in my data dashboard?	Generally no. School year data is made available in MDD after it is certified and published as part of each fall's Illinois Report Card release. If your district participates in the optional upload of interim assessment data into MDD, for example, those would continue to be available.
