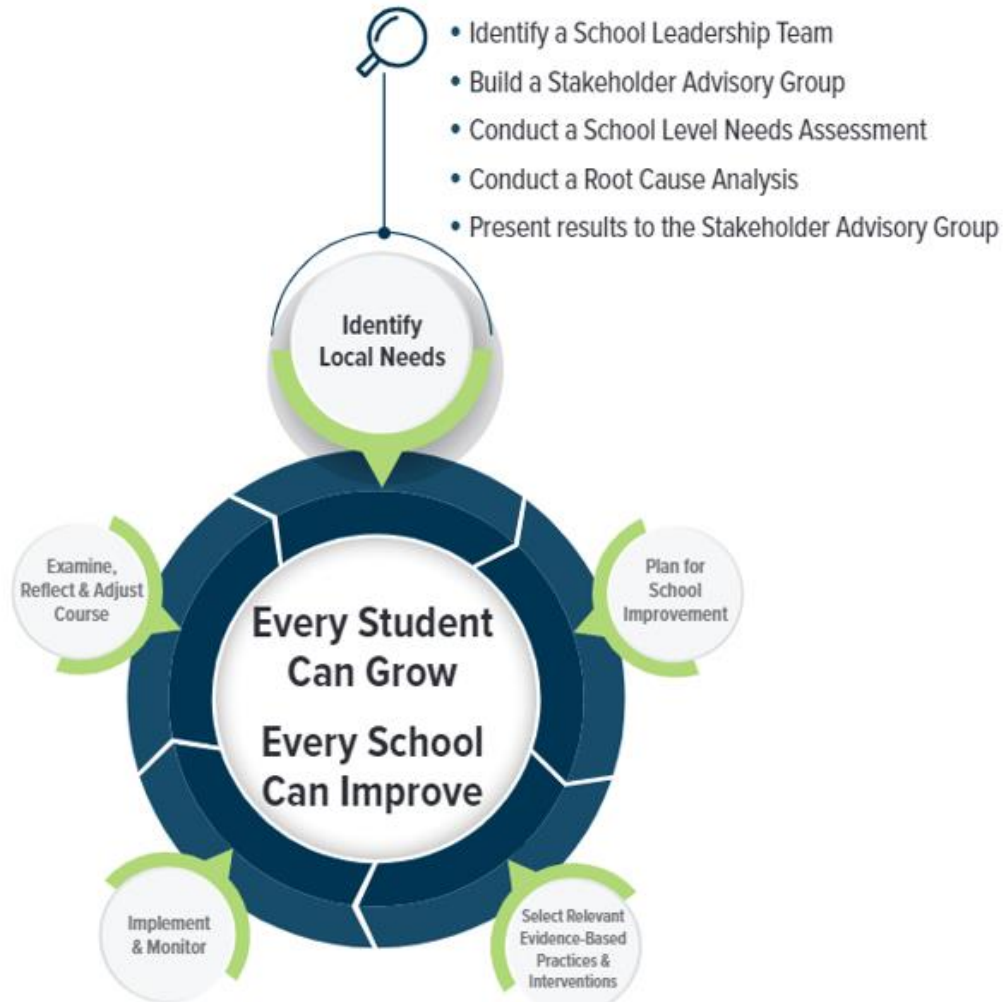

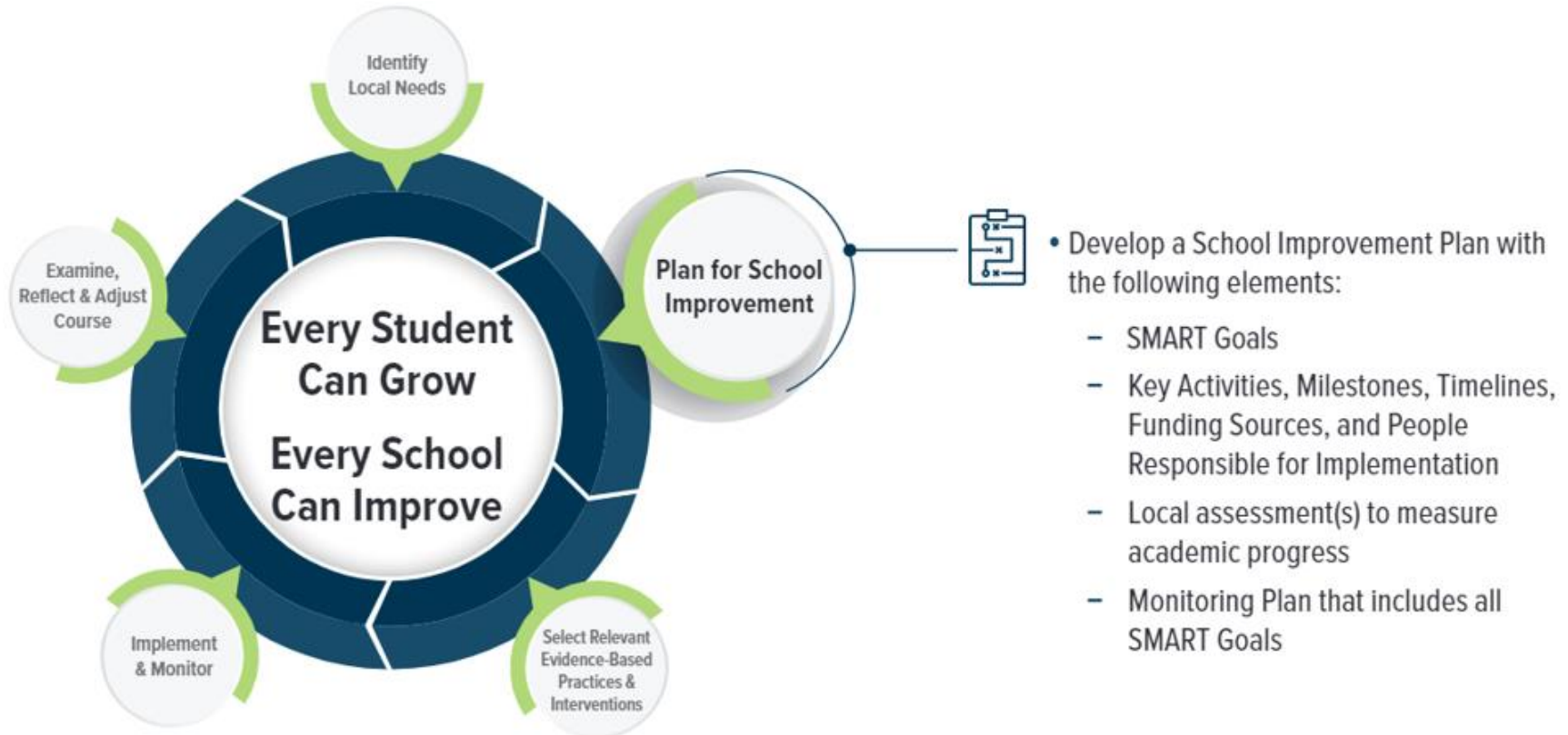

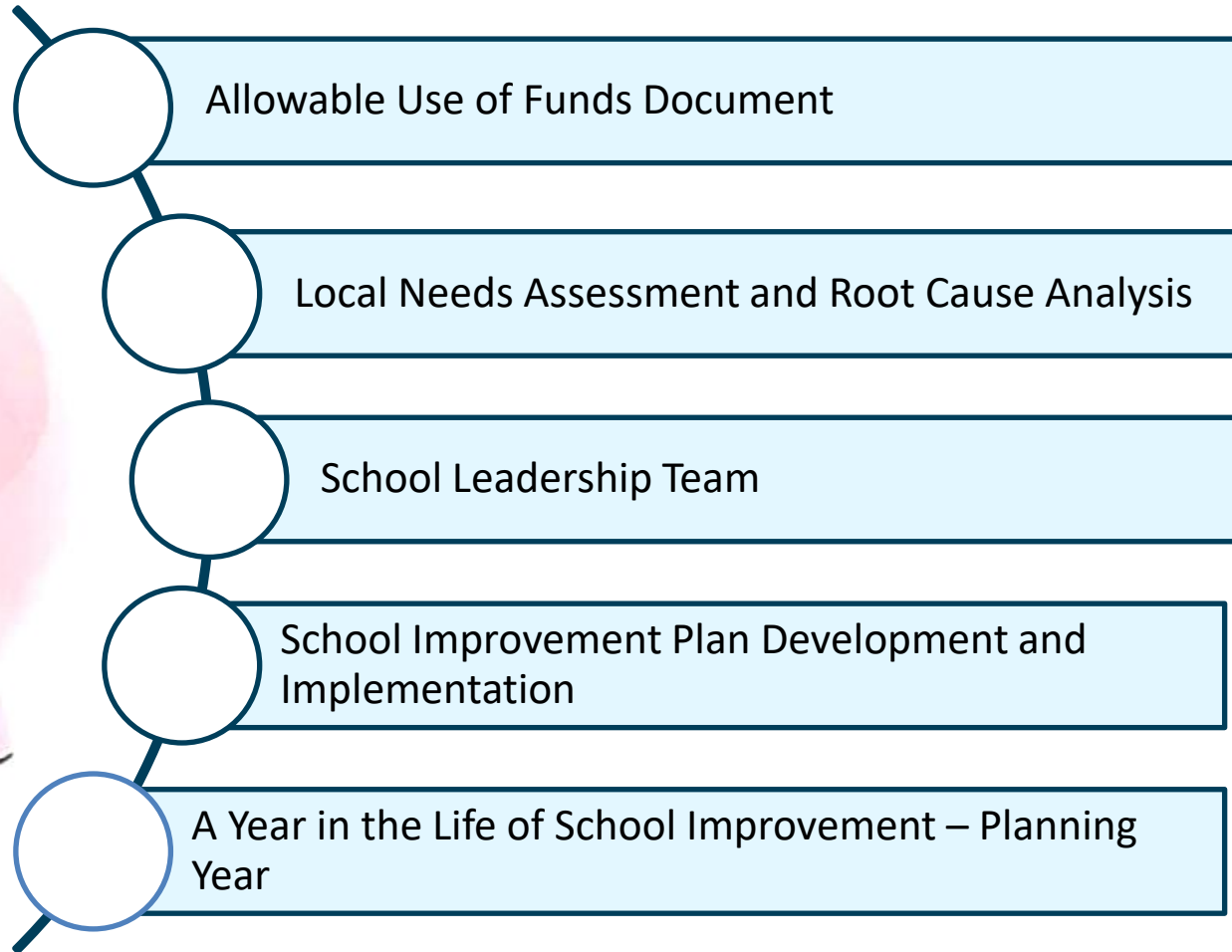

What If...

What happens for a school's funding that was designated as targeted on RC18 or RC19 but then designated as comprehensive on RC22?

Schools that were designated as targeted on RC18 or RC19 and then designated as comprehensive on RC22 will receive the funding that they would have normally gotten in FY23 and the planning year grant of \$15,000. In FY24 they will receive Implementation Year 1 grant funding only.



What If...

What reporting requirements does a school that was designated as targeted on RC18 or RC19 but is now designated as comprehensive on RC22?

Districts will still need to complete the quarterly expenditure reports for FY2023 funds that were allocated to targeted to comprehensive resets. The school will NOT need to complete the SIR 2 or SIR 3 as a targeted school. Moving forward, the school will adhere to all program and reporting requirements for a newly designated comprehensive school.



What If...

What happens to my previous designation if I was targeted, and I am newly designated as comprehensive?

Any school that was designated as targeted in RC 18 or 19 and received a new designation as a comprehensive school on this 2022 report card is seen as a re-set: and will be required to follow the guidelines for the newly designated comprehensive schools.
