

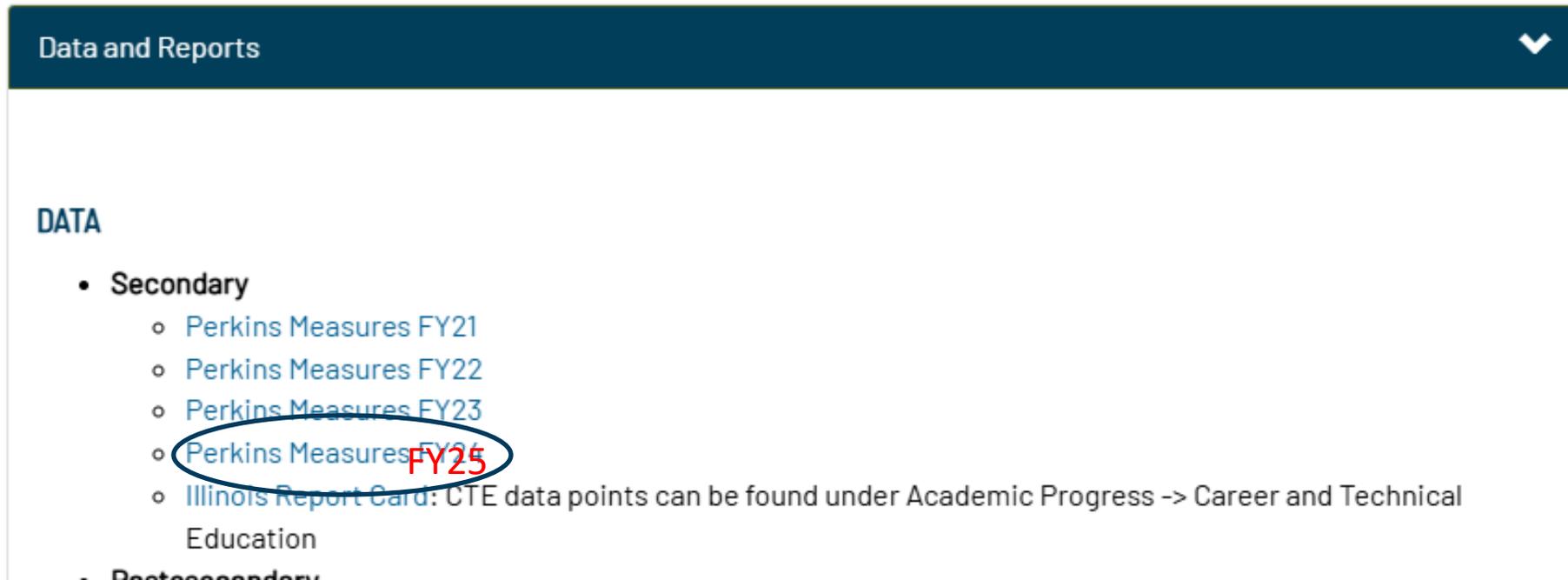
EFE Program Improvement Plan

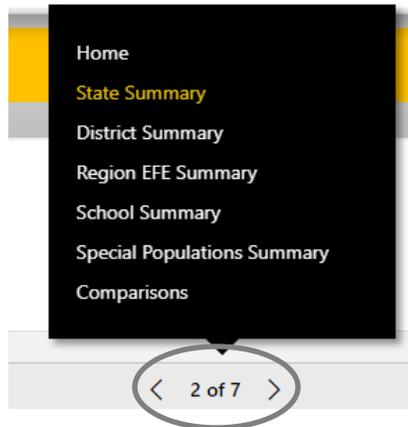
EFE Annual Report Data

1. Go to the **Region EFE Summary** page (page 4 of 7)
2. Use the drop-down box on the top left of the page to ***select*** your region.
3. This page provides a visual representation of the regions Perkins performance indicator data.
4. Review the percentages for each indicator for your region and record those on your FY25 Annual Report.
 - **Green** = have met target
 - **Blue** = within the 90% target range
 - **Red** = did not meet target (PIP required)

If you mark “yes”, you will also need to include narrative on disparities or gaps in performance for that indicator on the Annual Report document. *See slide 7 for examples*

If you mark “no”, you will address the disparities or gaps in performance on the required Program Improvement Plan (PIP) for that indicator. *There is no need to include the disparity or gap analysis on the Annual Report for those indicators where you have marked “no”. See slide 8 for examples*

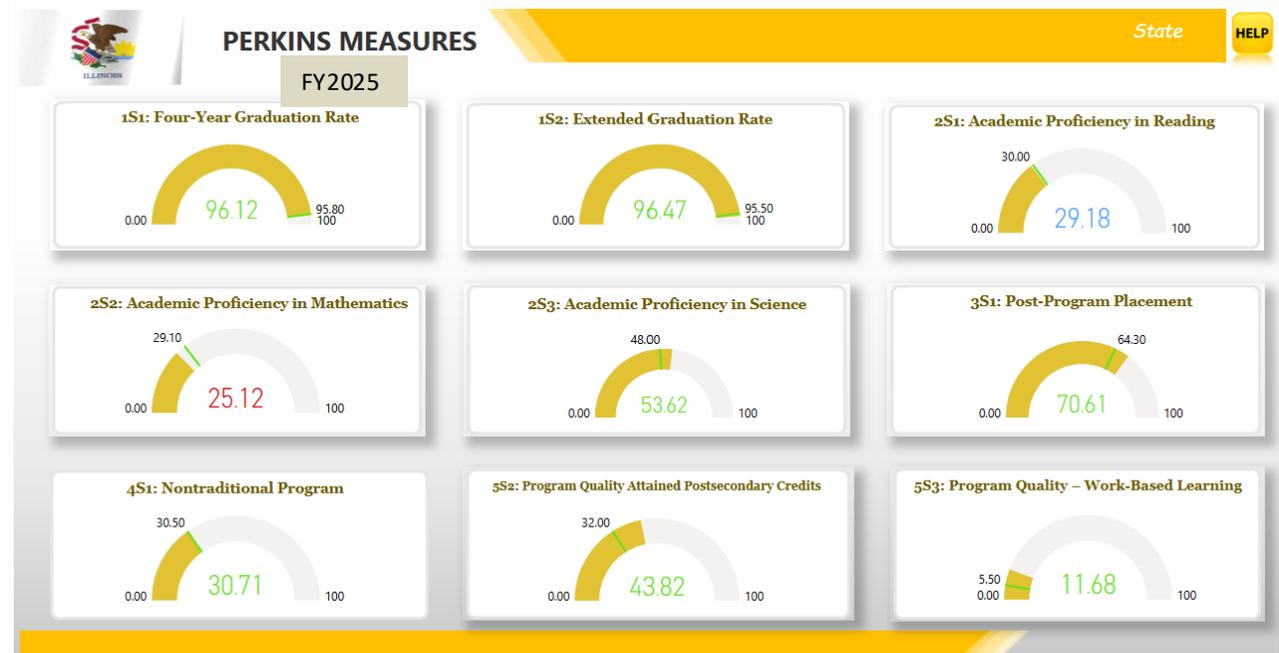
Click on the page number option to select various screens or you can use the arrows to move through pages.

Notice the colors on the Perkins indicator percentages.

Green = have met target

Blue = within the 90% target range

Red = did not meet target (PIP required)



Identification of Disparities and Gaps

1. Go to the **District Summary** page (page 3 of 7) and **School Summary** (page 5 of 7).
2. Use the drop-down boxes on the top of the pages to select the districts and schools within your region.
3. Identify which Districts and/or Schools have not met. This information can be included in your disparity and gap reporting for your region.
4. Go to the **Special Populations Summary** page (page 6 of 7).
5. Use the drop-down boxes on the top of the page to select a specific special populations group.
 - a. The first result will show the percentages of those students across the state within the special populations you selected that have met the state target (green), met within the 90% allowance (blue), or did not meet (red).
6. Use the drop-down boxes on the top of the page to filter down to Region, District or School.
7. Identify which Special Populations group have not met. This information should be included in your disparity and gap reporting for your region.

Identification of Disparities and Gaps

1. Go to the **Comparisons** page (page 7 of 7).
2. This page allows you to compare multiple points of data from race/ethnicity and special populations.
 - a. Use the drop-down boxes on the left side to select “all”. Then use the drop-down boxes across the top to select a Region, select a District, and select a School.
 - b. The results displayed from your selections show the State percentages of all students in meeting the performance indicators. The Region, District and School graphics display the percentages of students meeting the performance indicators within your selection.
3. There are various data comparisons that can be created on this page by using both the left side race/ethnicity/special populations drop downs and the top region, district, and school drop downs.

Establishing new CTSOs has been a challenge, however, we have successfully implemented 2 new chapters thanks to new collaboration efforts with industry partners and professional development opportunities for teachers interested in starting a new chapter. Three districts within the region failed to meet the state target as well as the 90% allowance. Further analysis shows that white students in all three districts were the only subgroup to meet the target. Special education and low-income students attained the lowest percentages within the entire EFE region, which is also reflected within these three districts.
