Gifted and Accelerated Validations

- A student whose Gifted and Accelerated record is being added or updated should have a valid district enrollment record in SIS that includes the following:
 - Enrollment record Home RCDT matches Gifted and Accelerated record's Home RCDT
 - Enrollment record School Year matches Gifted and Accelerated record's School Year





Gifted and Accelerated Validations

- Only Home RCDT can add/edit a Gifted and Accelerated record for a student enrolled in their district
- Only students in grades K 12 can have a Gifted and Accelerated record
- Only for enrollments in SY 2020 or Later
- Can only add/edit records for current or previous school, when valid enrollment exists.

Accelerated Placement

Means the practice of assigning a student to a specific content area at a higher instructional level than is typical, given the student's grade for the purpose of providing access to appropriately challenging learning opportunities in one or more subject areas.

- 00 Student not in accelerated program
- 01 Student is accelerated for ELA Only.
- 02 Student is accelerated for Math Only.
- 03 Student is accelerated for Single Subject other than ELA/Math.
- 04 Student is accelerated for Multiple Subjects, but not Whole Grade
- 05 Whole Grade Acceleration
- 06 Student is Accelerated for Science Only
- 07 Parent Opt Out; Student is identified for Acceleration in one or more subjects and is not enrolled in accelerated Coursework or Program





Gifted Test

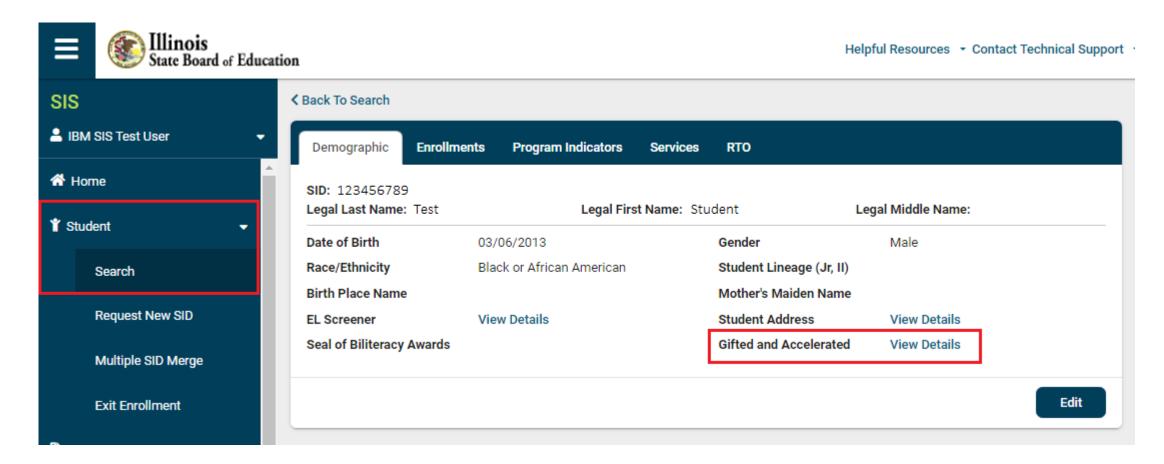
Gifted Children: "Children who give evidence of high-performance capability in areas such as intellectual, creative, artistic, leadership capacity, or specific academic fields, and who require services or activities not ordinarily provided by the school in order to fully develop such capabilities".

- 04 Student was not tested District does NOT have an assessment for gifted





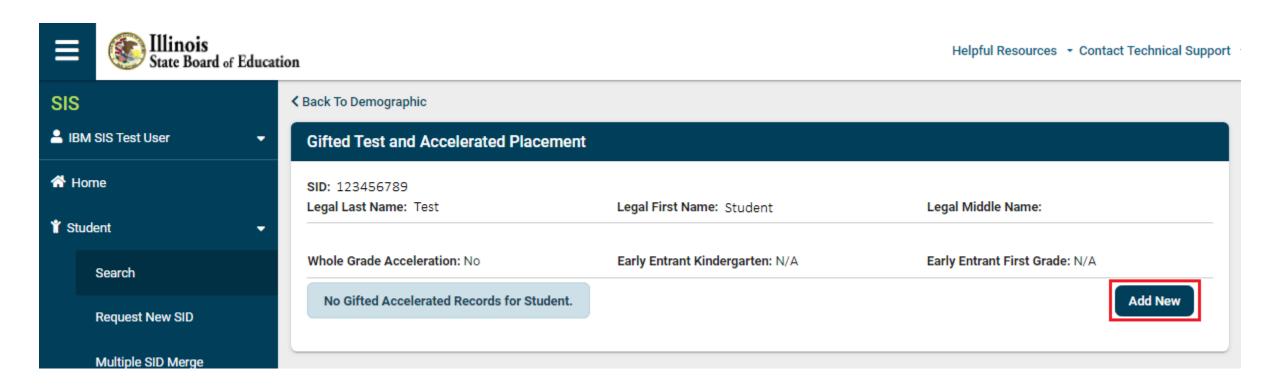











What is the end reporting need for this collection?

- Report Card: the number and percentage of all students who have been assessed for placement in a gifted education or advanced academic program and, of those students:

 (i) the racial and ethnic breakdown, (ii) the percentage who are classified as low-income, and (iii) the number and percentage of students who received direct instruction from a teacher who holds a gifted education endorsement and, of those students, the percentage who are classified as low-income
- "Gifted education" means educational services, including differentiated curricula and instructional methods, designed to meet the needs of gifted children as defined in Article 14A of this Code.
