DESCRIPTION

Knowing the Gifted Learner is a 30-week, self-paced, five-module course that provides K-12 educators licensed in Illinois a foundational understanding in teaching and leading advanced learners.

The course is framed by the seven Teacher Preparation Standards from the National Association for Gifted Children. Social emotional learning topics are also covered.

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will earn 96 Professional Development hours and a badge that will be included on their Illinois Professional Educator License.
