


# Content Test Waiver for Subsequent Science or Social Science Endorsements

Pursuant to Illinois Administrative Code Section 25.100 (e)(2)(B), “individuals who hold one senior high science or social science endorsement may add additional senior high endorsements in the same subject (i.e., science or social science) by completing 12 semester hours of content specific coursework **or** by passing the applicable content-area test.” To apply this exemption to an eligible candidate’s Educator Licensure Information System (ELIS) account, please follow the steps below.

## How to add the content test waiver for eligible candidates:

1. Log in to ELIS for Administrators.
2. After signing in, choose “Incomplete Entitlements” on the home page.



3. Go to the “Not Eligible” tab.


7. If any candidate(s) need to be removed, click the “x.”
