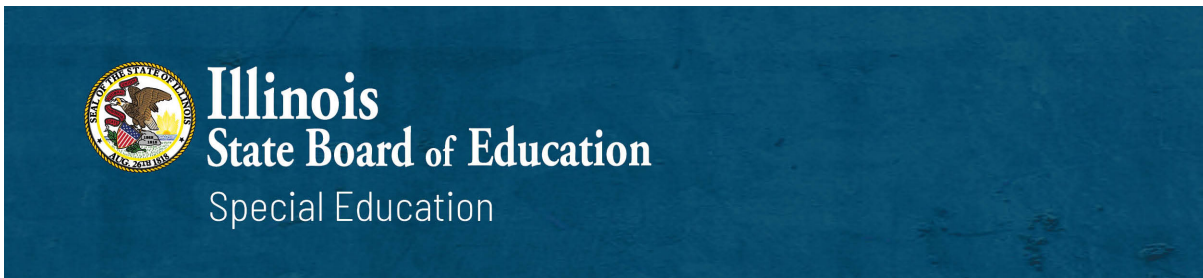

## Follow-Up Information Summary of ARP Funds

This message is to summarize [information sent Feb. 15 via IWAS](#) for Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds, which expire on **Sept. 30, 2023**.

Districts that submitted a fiscal year 2022 IDEA ARP application and have not expended all of their funds by June 30, 2023, will need to submit an FY 2024 application once carryover has been loaded. Districts must submit final expenditure reports in IWAS no later than July 20, 2023, in order to receive access to the FY 2024 IDEA ARP application.

Districts that did not submit an FY 2022 IDEA ARP application prior to June 30, 2022, **must** submit an FY 2023 IDEA ARP application as soon as possible. The FY 2023 application already has the amount available loaded as carryover. In this instance, an FY 2024 application will not be required.
