Purpose of the Template:

A template used to track candidates seeking licensure amid the COVID-19 disaster proclamation. Each IHE should submit the template indicating the candidate information of those affected. The candidates included on this template should be:

1. Those that qualify for an initial teaching PEL under the student teaching and/or grade of C-exemption;

and/or

2. Those that qualify for admission into an alternative program or to begin student teaching under the content test exemption.

How to Complete the Template:

Complete the template columns for each of the affected candidates. Column descriptions are below:

- A: IHE Name
- B: Candidate Last Name- Name as it is in ELIS
- C: Candidate First Name- Name as it is in ELIS
- D: IEIN
- E: Endorsement Code- Codes provided below
- F: Exemption 1- Did not complete the student teaching portion

Exemption 1 applies to candidates that were enrolled and active in student teaching and due to school closures during the COVID-19 disaster proclamation were unable to complete student teaching in its entirety.

G: **Exemption 2**- Used a pass/fail grade instead of a C- or above

Exemption 2 applies to candidates that were enrolled in coursework (course, internship, student teaching, practicum, etc.) and due to school closures and institution policies a pass/fail (or equivalent) grading system was implemented for courses instead of a grade.

H: Exemption 3- Did not take the content test

Exemption 3 applies to candidates that were unable to complete a content test due to the closure of testing centers during the COVID -19 disaster proclamation. This exemption affects those entering into an alternative program and those beginning student teaching.
