### SAT, PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10

SAT w/ Essay materials should be arriving soon for the March 22 assessment date. Please make sure that you have all the materials you need to administer the test. Please contact College Board Support for assistance if there is a discrepancy in your order.

All orders for tests were placed back in November via the spreadsheet that was filled out. If you plan on testing all your students, that roster should have contained all student names. Only a small overage of tests is sent along with the Pre-IDs that were created from that roster.

We have over 95% of IIKA schools rostered into the Pearson PAN system. If your school has IIKA scholarship recipients and you have not accessed the Pearson PAN system, please contact Mr. Potempa at <a href="mailto:rostempa@isbe.net">rpotempa@isbe.net</a> for support or access to the Pearson PAN system.

Please make sure to go into PAN and fill out the "Critical Errors" (the orange circles next to your students' names). To correct these errors, go to Set Up – Students, select the students with the error, then go to Select Tasks and choose Registration and Start. You can review each student on this page and answer the orange highlighted sections.

Please make sure that you have assigned two tests to each of your students -- an English Language Arts test and a Math test. This can be done by going into Set Up — Students. Select all your students from the list and go to Select Tasks. Click on Registration and press Start. From this page, go to the tab that says Manage Students Tests. Here you can choose each name from the Blank dropdown menu and assign them the appropriate test. Select Online for testing. You may be able to order paper tests, but you will have to contact Pearson directly to do so.

#### \*NEW This Year\* Illinois Science Assessment for Grades 5, 8, and 11

The Illinois Science Assessment is a web-based annual summative test given by ISBE to students in Grades 5, 8, and 11 across the state of Illinois.

Rostering of all Grades 5, 8 and 11 students has been completed. Please look for an email from Sean Clayton and John Hicks welcoming you to the ISBE Teach platform. If you have not received an email regarding your account, please contact Mr. Potempa at <a href="mailto:rpotempa@isbe.net">rpotempa@isbe.net</a>. All invitations for IIKA schools were sent to principals whose names are on file.

The average time length of the ISA is approximately two hours. There are three sections of the assessment that are approximately 40-45 minutes each. It is advised that the test begin and end on the same day. Once you're in the system, you can generate test codes for your students for the three sections of the test. You can only create one code at a time. Once a student finishes one section, you can generate the next code.

The testing window for the ISA is currently open. Please make sure to complete all testing by April 28.
