## College Board Grade 11 Establishment Survey

Thank you for completing the College Board Grade 11 Establishment Survey. The next step is the student rostering phase. Each school that has established that it has a Grade 11 IIKA scholar will be sent a secure Excel file from ISBE Principal Consultant Rob Potempa to fill out with student information. The roster request will be sent out in mid-October.

## Establishment Survey 2023-24 School Year for Grades 3-10

The Establishment Survey is now open and is in the <u>IWAS system</u>. It is prepopulated with information submitted in last year's survey and from ISBE's Entity Profile System. You will be asked to verify and/or make the appropriate corrections to names, email addresses, etc. Once you submit it, you do have the opportunity to go back and make changes as long as the survey is up and running. The survey will remain open until Nov. 30, 2023.

All nonpublic schools that currently have or anticipate having IIKA scholarship recipients in Grades 3-10 must fill out the Establishment Survey to establish the school as a testing site for the IAR, Illinois Science Assessment, and PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10.

The Establishment Survey also asks for an estimate of how many IIKA students in Grades 9 and 10 will be taking either the PSAT 8/9 and/or PSAT 10. If your school is planning to test all Grade 9 and/or Grade 10 students, please include those numbers in the boxes, as requested.

2024 Spring Testing Comparison Sheet for PSAT and SAT

All College Board-required testing for IIKA scholarship recipients is to be given within a six-week testing window this school year. The testing window will be March 18-April 26, 2024. All testing must be completed within the testing window. No testing or make up tests will be available beyond April 26. All IIKA scholarship recipients in Grades 9, 10, and 11 are required to test during the spring 2024 testing window.

The College Board ordering system is open for schools to place their PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10 orders. **ISBE does not order or roster students for PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10 testing. Please note that all IIKA students must test during the state testing window of March 18-April 26.** 

**MPORTANT CHANGE** – Schools that choose to test all Grade 11 students along with the IIKA scholarship recipients during the spring testing window **must** administer the SAT w/Essay. It is <u>not possible</u> to administer SAT w/o Essay and SAT w/Essay during the state testing window.
