IIKA Scholarship Recipients

If your school is not sure they have any IIKA scholarship recipients for the 2022-23 school year, please contact your school's business manager and/or tuition manager. They should be able to provide a list to you. ISBE does not have a list of IIKA scholarship recipients. Scholarship granting organizations should reach out to your school's business or tuition manager to let them know they have IIKA scholarship recipients for the 2022-23 school year.

IIKA 2022-23 Assessment Dates

NEW This Year Illinois Science Assessment

All IIKA scholarship recipients in grades 5, 8 and 11 will be required to take the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA). The testing window for the science assessment is March 1, 2023, through April 28, 2023. More information will be forthcoming regarding this assessment and rostering of students.

IIKA Establishment Survey – Closing in November

All private schools with IIKA students in Grades 3-10 must fill out the Establishment Survey for the 2022-23 school year. This survey allows each school to update its contact information with the Illinois State Board of Education, so we have the most current information going into the new school year. If you find an error in the diocese in which your school is included or your school is not listed in the survey, please contact assessment@isbe.net.

Please note ALL Archdiocese of Chicago schools have been established through Clare Sullivan and the Office of Catholic Schools. There is no need for any Archdiocesan schools to fill out the survey. It has been done for you.
