If you would like to test all of your Grade 11 students, please put the total number in your count. This form needs to be completed by <a href="Sept. 20">Sept. 20</a>. - Once your school has received its SAT with Essay scores, please make sure to submit a PDF of
  your IIKA student scores. Please DO NOT send them via email. You must use the ISBE
  Attachment Manager for a secure transfer of scores. Directions on how to submit scores are
  below. We need these scores sent to us so that an independent auditor can review the scores of
  all of the students in the program.
- Click on the Send ISBE a file link. Once there, complete the fields, and select Invest in Kids from
  the ISBE email Name dropdown menu. In the Subject field, please type in your School Name and
  RCDTS Code and then press the Submit button. If you do not know your RCDTS Code, please
  click HERE to go to the ISBE RCDTS Code search engine.
