 - Physical Fitness and professional growth (employee physical exam, other tests)
 - 105 ILCS 5/24-5
 - Institutes or Inservice day shall include instruction on prevalent student chronic health conditions
 - 105 ILCS 5/3-11
 - Administering medications
 - 105 ILCS 5/10-22.21b
- Illinois Student Records Act

- Care of Students with Diabetes Act
 - 105 ILCS 145/5
 - Delegated care aide
 - Diabetes Care Plan basis for 504 Plan
 - Accommodations
 - Training
 - Permits undesignated glucagon
- Seizure Smart School Act
 - 105 ILCS 150/1
 - Delegated care aide
 - Accommodations
 - Training



Student health exam requirements

- Illinois School Code <u>105 ILCS 5/27-8.1</u> Health examinations and immunizations
 - Exclusion if not in compliance
- Public Health Code <u>Section 665</u>
 - Requirements
 - Intervals
 - Components
- Communicable Disease Code <u>Section 690</u>
 - Infectious disease
 - Notifications
 - Susceptibility



Vision and Hearing Screening

- VISION AND HEARING SCREENING
- Vision and Hearing Test Act (410 ILCS 205)
- Hearing screening: <u>77 IL Admin. Code 675</u>
- Vision screening: 77 IL Admin. Code 685

**Hearing and vision screening reports are due to IDPH by June 30th of each year

 - ISBE rule 226.800: Personnel required to be qualified (nursing interventions)
 - ISBE rule 226.860: Qualifications of evaluators
 - ISBE rule 226.160: Medical review: performance of health evaluation for student for IEP



Reporting dates to remember

ISBE Student Health Data Important Dates	
Immunization/Health Examination	
Students submit to school by	October 15, 2022 or an earlier exclusion date set by the district
IWAS system opens for data-entry	September 1, 2022
IWAS system deadline for submission	November 15, 2022
Eye Examination	
Students submit to school by	October 15, 2022
IWAS system opens for data entry	September 1, 2022
IWAS system deadline for submission	June 30, 2023 at 11:59 p.m.
Dental Examination	
Students submit to school by	May 15, 2023
IWAS system opens for data entry	May 16, 2023
IWAS system deadline for submission	June 30, 2023 at 11:59 p.m.
