**The Prairie State Achievement Examination (PSAE)** measures student achievement relative to the Illinois Learning Standards for reading, mathematics, science, and writing. PSAE Day 1 consists of tests in English, reading, mathematics, science, and writing developed by ACT. PSAE Day 2 consists of tests in reading and mathematics developed by ACT and a test in science developed by the Illinois State Board of Education with assistance from Illinois teachers.

The table to the right gives brief descriptions of the four performance levels and the score range for each subject at each performance level.

The table below shows the link between the PSAE and the Illinois Learning Standards, your scores and performance levels, and the percent of scores in your school and in the district and state at or below your scores.

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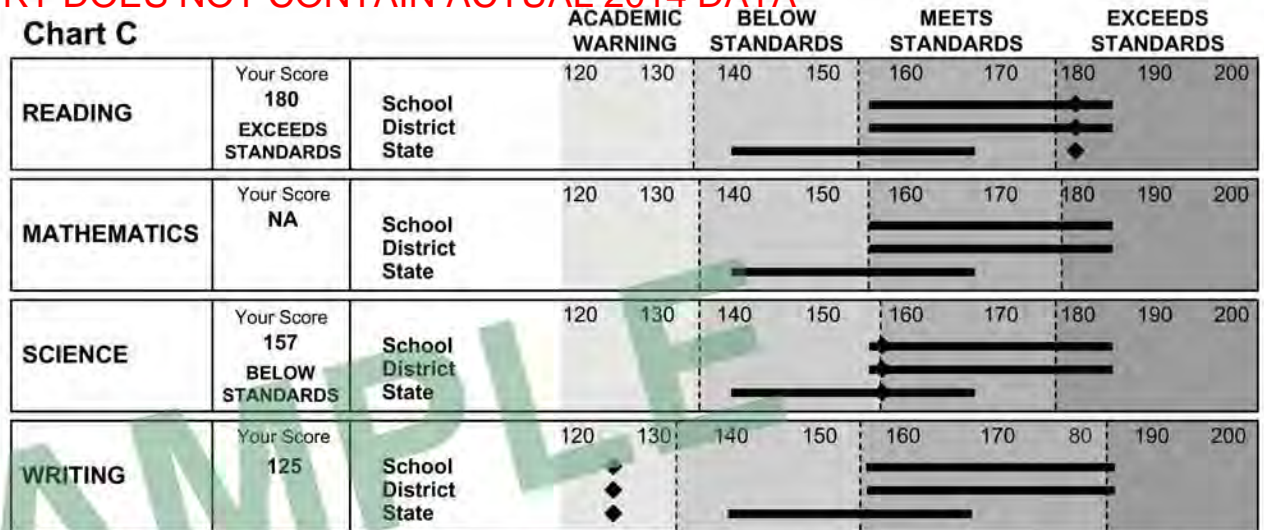
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**YOUR SCORES & PERFORMANCE LEVELS**

**Chart C** shows your PSAE scores (represented by the diamonds) and performance levels on the PSAE reading, mathematics, and science tests. The score range for each test is 120 to 200. The horizontal black bars show the approximate range scored by the middle half (fifty percent) of the students in your school, district, and state. For each group, about one-fourth of the students scored above, or to the right of, the bar and about one-fourth scored below, or to the left of, the bar. The vertical dashed lines divide the scale into the four performance levels.

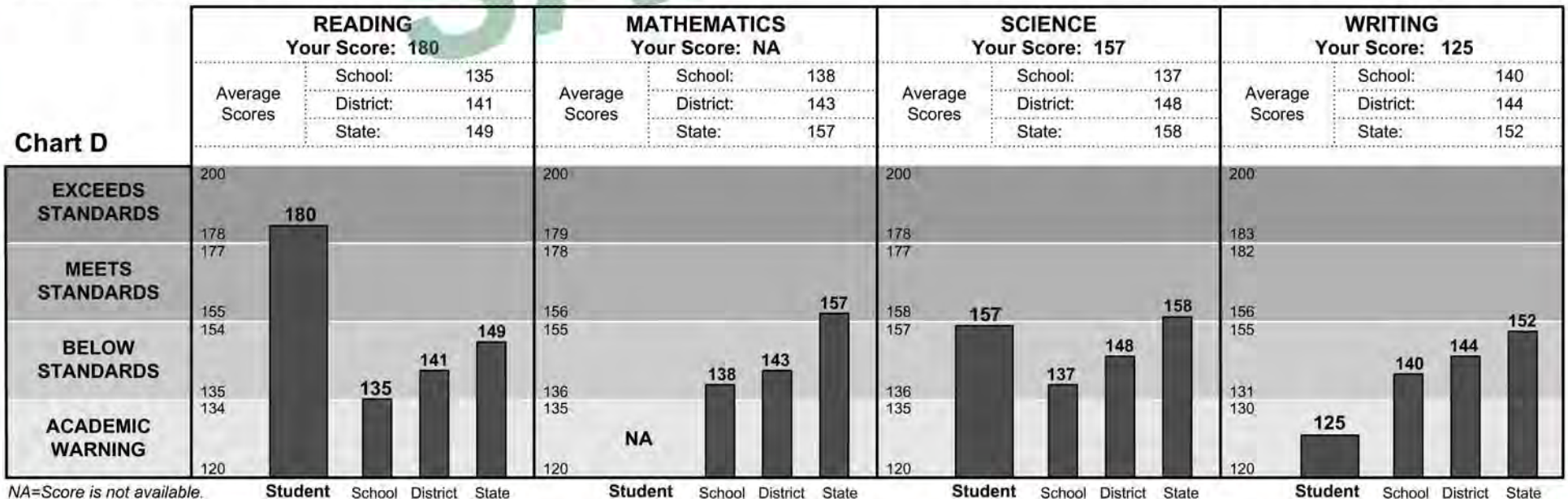
**Chart D** is a graphical representation of your PSAE scores and the average PSAE scores for your school, district, and state.
