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
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YOUR SCORES & PERFORMANCE LEVELS

Chart C shows your PSAE scores (represented by the diamonds) and performance levels on the PSAE reading. mathematics, and science tests. The score range for each test is 120 to 200. The horizontal black bars show the approximate range scored by the middle half (fifty percent) of the students in your school, district, and state. For each group, about one-fourth of the students scored above, or to the right of, the bar and about onefourth score below, or to the left of, the bar. The vertical dashed lines divide the scale into the four performance levels.

Chart D is a graphical representation of your PSAE scores and the average PSAE scores for your school, district, and state.



NOTE: Since no single test is a perfect measure of a student's achievement, a performance level classification based on a score within five points of a cut point should be interpreted with care.
