



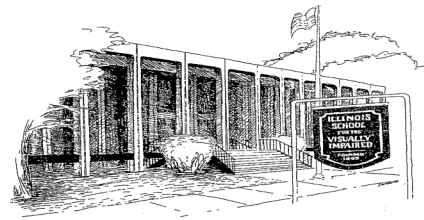

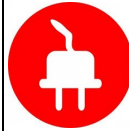

Where & When

Three one-week camps will be held June 18-24, 2017. All camps will be held on the ISVI campus in Jacksonville, Illinois, West of Springfield on Interstate 72.

Who May Attend and Cost

Students who are visually impaired, ages 9–19, are eligible to attend the camps if they reside in Illinois, do not currently attend ISVI, are not high school graduates, and have appropriate independent living skills. All one-week camps are free to eligible students.

Transportation

Families are responsible for providing transportation to and from the camps.
