

## Illinois Implementation Workshop for IIKA Schools Participating in Spring 2023 Testing

## Prepare for Spring 2023 Administration of PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and SAT School Day with Essay

Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) is excited to offer this free 2.5 hour in-person workshop designed to provide participants with key changes and updates for the spring 2023 Illinois Invest in Kids Act (IIKA) assessment program which requires that PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and SAT School Day with Essay be administered to qualified IIKA scholarship recipients.

<u>Public Act 100-465</u> established the Illinois Invest in Kids Act. The Act includes a five-year tax credit scholarship program for eligible students who attend qualified nonpublic schools in Illinois.

A portion of the Act requires that scholarship recipients shall be annually assessed at the qualified school where the student attends school in the same manner in which students that attend public schools are annually assessed pursuant to Section 2-3.64a5 of the School Code and that such qualified schools shall pay costs associated with this requirement.

ISBE, through the Illinois Invest in Kids Act, requires all scholarship recipients attending a private school in grade 9 to take the PSAT 8/9, those in grade 10 to take the PSAT 10, and those in grade 11 to take the SAT with Essay. Attendance at an in-person workshop is optional, and ISBE will post on its website a recorded webinar version of the content presented at <a href="https://www.isbe.net/Pages/testinvestinkidsact.aspx">https://www.isbe.net/Pages/testinvestinkidsact.aspx</a>.

If you are not familiar with College Board's SAT Suite of Assessments, we strongly encourage you to attend an in-person workshop.

Each session will begin with information regarding the implementation of the SAT with Essay and be followed by information regarding the implementation of the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10. This schedule allows participants from schools with no grade 9 or 10 scholarship recipients to leave after the SAT with Essay presentation.

The implementation workshops, led by College Board, will cover the following topics:

- Updates and changes for the spring 2023 SAT with Essay administration
- Overview of PSAT 10 and PSAT 8/9 administration guidelines
- Thorough review of Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) accommodations and updates
- Test day information, planning, and security
- Overview of Official SAT Practice on the Khan Academy website
