



Serve as a companion to support the work of the school leader, leadership team, and SAG (Stakeholder Advisory Group) in the school improvement process utilizing the SIP developed during the planning year.

The ISLI Target Services:

SIP Support Focus Points

- Embedding data analysis systems.
- Ensuring a standards-aligned ELA and math curricula for schoolspecific grade levels.
- Developing common & formative assessments aligned to the ELA and math curricula.
- Examining equity within school operations and the instructional program.
- Monitoring social-emotional wellness of students and staff.
- Strengthening school culture and climate.

Coaching Support

- Providing onsite and virtual support for school improvement.
- Providing school leader support.
- Providing school leadership and PLC support.

School Improvement Conference

- Providing access to state and national school improvement experts.
- Facilitating team planning and learning.
- Enhancing networking with other participating leaders.

Professional Learning Support

- Enhancing effective leadership skills.
- Facilitating effective team development.
- Ensuring effective collection and analysis of school-wide data.
- Ensuring effective development of ILS-aligned ELA and math curricula.
- Ensuring effective development of common assessments.
- Ensuring effective development of data-analysis skills to conduct the continuous school improvement process.

Expectations of ISLI Principals

- Principals will participate in initial intake meetings to gain support of administration and their Boards of Education.
- Principals will attend a combination of virtual and in-person monthly meetings.
- Principals will attend the annual summer school improvement conference.
- Principals will meet and collaborate with coaches throughout the length of the program.
- Principals will participate in ongoing conversations and collaboration with the ISLI project team.
- Principals will support the work of the school leadership team to successfully monitor, implement and adjust the collaboratively-developed school improvement plan to advance student learning.

Expectations of ISLI Principals

- Principals will support the work of the teacher teams in the development or modification of ELA and math curricula and common assessments and provide professional development for the entire faculty on their implementation.
- Principals will engage the faculty in data-driven decision-making processes utilizing PLCs and data teams to increase the data analysis skills of teachers.
- Principals will provide professional development to faculty on curriculum and assessment
 alignment with state standards, professional learning communities and data teams, assessments,
 and data analysis processes.
