The Commission protects the rights of persons with disabilities through its 3 primary programs:

- **The Human Rights Authority**
- **The Legal Advocacy Service**
- **The Office of State Guardian**

The **Human Rights Authority** ensures disability rights protections for both children and adults with disabilities by conducting investigations of alleged rights violations committed against persons with disabilities by providers that serve them, including special education programs. The program focuses on systemic improvements to policies, procedures and practices that improve rights protections for current and future service recipients.

The **Legal Advocacy Service** provides legal advice and representation for persons with disabilities.

The **Office of State Guardian** serves as guardian for adults with disabilities as appointed by the courts.

The Commission also provides information about **disability rights and adult guardianship**.
