The KIDStech® system allows teachers, program administrators, and other designated staff to access the Kindergarten Individual Development Survey (KIDS) assessment and to conduct assessments online via the Internet. KIDStech stores the data entered by teachers in a secure database and automatically produces a variety of assessment reports for both individual children and groups of children. The California Department of Education Desired Results Developmental Profile – School Readiness® (DRDP-SRD) and DRDP/tech system were selected by the Illinois State Board of Education as the basis for the KIDS assessment. The KIDS assessment has been completed and calibrated. It is a psychometrically valid assessment. DRDP/tech will be adapted into KIDStech and integrated into the Illinois School Information System in future years.

Developmentally appropriate and aligned, the KIDS assessment provides useful information to teachers and administrators in order to better address children's learning and developmental needs over time. Use of the KIDS assessment is an essential strategy to close the readiness gap and ensure all children thrive in their earliest years. KIDS is a comprehensive process designed to provide information about children's competencies across developmental domains over time and to inform whether Illinois' kindergarteners have the skills and knowledge needed to succeed in school.
