Dear Mr. Estvan:

Thank you for the Open Letter to the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) presented by you and several other advocates at the ISBE November Board meeting. We have heard your concerns and, as a result, will open a Public Inquiry into the facts surrounding special education at the Chicago Public Schools. The purpose of the Public Inquiry is to collect the facts surrounding the system of special education at CPS in a truthful and trustworthy manner. A framework for the public inquiry is attached to this letter.

As the advocates who raised concerns, you and your colleagues will have the opportunity to participate fully in the Public Inquiry. The Public Inquiry Team will ask you to present evidence supporting the allegations you have made and may ask you to testify at public hearings regarding such evidence. We appreciate your participation and commitment to this process.

At this point, we are finalizing the public inquiry team. We have contracted with Nancy Krent, professor of school law at Chicago Kent and Loyola Law Schools, to facilitate the Public Inquiry. She will be in contact with you and with CPS to further define the issues and review the operating procedures for the Inquiry.
