



Bilingual/ESL Licensure



Bilingual/ESL Licensure

- Bilingual Endorsement (with language) Pk-12
- ESL Endorsement Pk-12
- ENL Endorsement 9-12 (allows for teaching ESL)
- ENL Endorsement + Bilingual (with language) 9-12 (allows for teaching ESL & bilingual)
- ELS-TBE Pk-12
- ELS-VIT endorsed in the language



Updates



Updates for Endorsement

- Bilingual/ESL endorsements are now Pk-12
- Elementary endorsement is now 1-6 as of September 1st, 2019



Bilingual Endorsement



Bilingual Classrooms

- 20 or more EBs with the same language in the school
- Instruction in the students' native language in all core subject areas
- Instruction must include content in the students'/parents' history and culture
- Provide English as a Second Language instruction



Bilingual Endorsement PK-12

- PEL (+ grade level endorsement)
 - +Early Childhood Endorsement: Pk-3
 - +Elementary: K-9
 - NEW Teachers (9/1/19): K-6
 - +Middle School: 5-8 + Content or Coteach
 - +Secondary: 6-12 + Content or Co-teach



Bilingual Endorsement Requirements

- 18 semester hours of coursework with a distribution:
 - Foundations of bilingual education
 - Assessment of bilingual students
 - Methods and materials for teaching limited-English proficient students in bilingual programs
 - Cross-cultural studies for teaching limited-English proficient students
 - Methods and materials for teaching English as a Second Language; AND
 - Completion of a minimum of 100 clock hours or three months of teaching experience in a bilingual program or programs;
 - Appropriate Target Language Proficiency or English Language Proficiency test (if applicable)



ELS-TBE

- PreK-12
- Requirements include:
 - Valid teaching certificate within 5 years from another state or country OR
 - Bachelor's degree or equivalent from another state or country,
 - Demonstrate proficiency in both English and the target language OR
 - Studied at a university with the target language or English,
 - Testing is not required if the applicant graduated from an institution where English and the target language were the medium of instruction.
- Valid: 5 fiscal years (non-renewal)
- Details:
 - Educator must be working towards the endorsement
 - Apply through ELIS account



ELS-VIT

- Applies educators that are part of the Exchange Visitor Teacher Program
- Valid for 3 fiscal years
- Includes the bilingual endorsement

ESL Endorsement



ESL Classrooms

- Does not need proficiency in language other than English
- ESL instruction is required
- May serve students of diverse linguistic and cultural background



ESL Endorsement PK-12

- PEL (+ grade level endorsement)
 - +Early Childhood Endorsement: Pk-3
 - +Elementary: K-9
 - NEW Teachers (9/1/19): K-6
 - +Middle School: 5-9 + Content or Coteach
 - +Secondary: 6-12 + Content or Co-teach



ESL Endorsement Requirements

- 18 semester hours of coursework with a distribution:
 - Linguistics
 - Theoretical foundations of teaching ESL
 - Assessment of the bilingual student
 - Methods and materials for teaching ESL
 - Cross-cultural studies for teaching limited-English proficient students, AND
- A minimum of 100 clock hours or three months of teaching experience with ESL students

Short-Term Approval & Reciprocity



Bilingual & ESL Short Term Approval

- Requirements:
 - Hold a valid PEL with endorsement on grade range AND
 - Transcripts with 9 hours of coursework in the subject area(Bilingual/ESL) or
 - A passing score on the corresponding Illinois Content Area Test.
 - Content area test only pertains to content taught in the Middle or HS setting.
 - The Target Language Proficiency test (TLP) does not count as content area test.
 - There is no content area test for Bilingual nor ESL.
- Valid:
 - 3 fiscal years (non-renewable)
- Details:
 - Educator must be working towards the endorsement
 - Apply through ELIS account



Reciprocity

- Illinois offers full reciprocity
- Educators are considered for all areas listed on their valid, comparable, out of state/country license
- Requirements:
 - A copy of your valid, comparable out of state/country license
 - A bachelor's degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution of higher education

Application Procedures & Resources



Application Procedures

- Applicants must set up an account in the Educator Licensure Information System (https://sec3.isbe.net/IWASNET/sign_up.aspx) and apply online through their ELIS account, view deficiency letters and see their credentials.
- A \$50 fee is required for all endorsement applications.
- Applicants with foreign credentials must:
 - Obtain foreign credential evaluation from one of the ISBE approved foreign credential evaluation agencies located at www.isbe.net/certification/html/foreign credential.htm.
 - Request course-by-course evaluation of all foreign transcripts and credentials.
 - Submit official transcripts containing all of the ESL/bilingual coursework taken.
 - Submit proof of completion of 100 clock hour of clinical experience in an ESL or bilingual setting.
