

<u>Public Act 103-0402</u> amends the Illinois School Code with the aim of elevating literacy instruction in Illinois. The Act imposes mandates on the Illinois State Board of Education to establish a robust literacy framework and enhance educator learning and development in evidence-based literacy instruction.

The act aims to significantly improve literacy rates among students by fostering an environment that supports reading and writing proficiency. This initiative not only targets academic success but also seeks to address broader societal challenges associated with low literacy levels.
